Quick Start

(EN)

1. Know the Device



Functions of the Touch key:

Click the Touch key to:

1. Return; or
2. Turn on the screen

2. Power On/Off



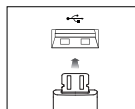
Note: the Bracelet must be activated through charging before the first use.

- (1) Pull the strap and remove the main body of the Bracelet;
- (2) Insert the metal charging terminal of the main body into the USB port to charge the Bracelet (please use the specified voltage and current (5V/500mA), and be careful not to reverse the polarity).

Downloading and Pairing

1. Download the APP

2. Pairing

Turn on the APP and Bluetooth. Search and select the device in the APP. Finally, bind the device in the APP.
Or go to the app > device > upper right corner and select the QR code scanner icon to scan the QR code in the watch screen to pair the device.

Screen Operations

Swipe the screen up/down

1. To switch among pages at the same level; or
2. To view long text or details.

Swipe the screen left/right

1. To switch among pages at the same level.

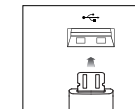
Nota: La pulsera debe activarse mediante carga antes del primer uso.

Descarga y emparejamiento

1. Descarga de la aplicación

2. Emparejamiento

Encienda la aplicación y Bluetooth. Busque y seleccione el dispositivo en la APLICACIÓN. Finalmente, vincule el dispositivo en la APLICACIÓN. También puede hacerlo desde el App > dispositivo > esquina superior derecha y seleccione el símbolo de escaner de código QR. Escanee el código que muestra la pantalla del reloj para emparejar el dispositivo.

Operaciones de la pantalla

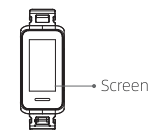
1. Cambiar entre las páginas en el mismo nivel.

Click the screen

1. To go to the sub-page;
2. To complete the corresponding action, depending on which on-screen button is clicked.

Click and hold the screen

1. To change the watch face wallpaper.



2. Keep the device dry;
3. Do not wear the device too tight.

- * Do not use household cleaners to clean the device. Use soap-free cleaners instead.
- * For stains that are difficult to remove, it is recommended to scrub with alcohol.

Waterproof performance: the device is not suitable for diving, swimming in the sea or sauna, it is suitable for swimming pool, shower (cold water) and swimming in shallows.

Functions

CT1serie2 supports 5ATM, full-screen touch, follow-hand operations, 14 sports modes, multiple dials in the cloud, and HR, SpO2, stress and sleep monitoring. For the operating instructions and FAQ, please start the APP and consult the User Guide.

Maintenance

Below are three recommendations on wearing and maintenance:

1. Keep the device clean;

Hacer clic en la pantalla

1. Ir a la subpágina;

Hacer clic y sostener la pantalla

1. Cambiar el fondo de pantalla frontal del reloj.



1. Mantener el dispositivo limpio;
2. Mantener el dispositivo seco;
3. No usar el dispositivo demasiado ajustado.

- * No utilizar limpiadores domésticos para limpiar el dispositivo. En cambio, se deben utilizar limpiadores libres de jabón.
- * Para las manchas que son difíciles de remover, se recomienda limpiar con alcohol.

Rendimiento impermeable: el dispositivo no es adecuado para bucear, nadar en el mar o en el sauna; es adecuado para piletas de natación, para la ducha (agua fría) y para la natación en aguas poco profundas.

Funciones

CT1serie2 es compatible con 5ATM, funciones táctiles a pantalla completa, funciones de seguimiento, 14 modos deportivos, múltiples marcaciones en la nube y monitoreo de HR, SpO2, estrés y sueño. Para obtener instrucciones de funcionamiento y preguntas frecuentes, inicie la aplicación para consultar la Guía del usuario.

Mantenimiento

A continuación se detallan tres recomendaciones acerca del uso y del mantenimiento:

Seguridad

- * A fin de evitar fallas en el dispositivo, incendio y explosión, nunca se debe colocar el dispositivo o sus accesorios en áreas de temperaturas extremadamente altas o extremadamente bajas.
- * Para evitar el daño al dispositivo, el daño a sus accesorios y fallas en el dispositivo, siempre se debe proteger el dispositivo contra impactos fuertes o choques.
- * No se debe desmontar o modificar el dispositivo o sus accesorios sin previa autorización. Cualquier falla del dispositivo debe ser remitida a nuestro personal de servicio de posventa.
