A•E•P ointment is an ointment consisting of retinol palmitate, which improves mucosal dryness and cornification, and tocopherol acetate, which improves peripheral circulatory disturbances, combined with gelatinized hydrocarbons. It is a skin preparation for use on the elbows, knees, heels, rough fingertips and palms, cracks, spots, and grapes.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

Apply this medicine to the affected area as needed.

[Precautions for Dosage and Administration]

- (1) Strictly follow the dosing schedule.
- (2) If this medicine is used in children, it should be used under the supervision of a parent.
- (3) Take care so that the medicine does not get into your eyes. If this medicine gets into your eyes, wash your eyes with water or lukewarm water immediately. If symptoms are severe, consult with an ophthalmologist.
