In addition, many of our solid wood cribs are bench-made in small local shops in the United States using traditional joinery techniques that cannot be accomplished in mass production. For other cribs, we employ precise CNC milling that allows us to realize designs that were previously unimaginable. This combination of the latest fabrication technology with traditional techniques and our cutting-edge designs is unique to Nursery Works. Low- and no-VOC finishes are used across all our products and our products are tested to governmental standards on an annual basis.

Please note that due to the handcrafted nature of our products and our use of solid woods, each piece is unique and may possess color variations and irregular wood grain or surface texture. These natural characteristics are part of the beauty of real wood, are not considered manufacturing defects and do not merit replacements.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Improper assembly can result in damage to your furniture or cause harm to your child. Proper assembly is critical to ensure a safe and comfortable end result. Please read all instructions before assembly and keep instructions for future use.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING:

To preserve the quality of your Nursery Works furniture we recommend periodically wiping with a damp, lint-free cotton cloth and a non-toxic cleaner. Never use window cleaner, ammonia products or other chemical sprays on acrylic. Distinctive acrylic furniture and accessories can last an eternity with minimal care and maintenance. Acrylic care consists of no more than normal wipe-cleaning, but care should be taken to avoid scratches. Acrylic is also stable when exposed to sunlight.

Below are additional guidelines for caring and maintaining our lucite furniture.

Use only a very soft damp cloth when cleaning acrylic surfaces.

It is possible to scratch acrylic, so NEVER use any scouring compounds or chemical cleaners such as Windex or other glass cleaners (even if they are environmentally friendly, organic or non-scented). Should anything ever stick to an acrylic surface (such as an adhesive label or gummy substance), do not use any type of solvent.

Never use the same cloth that you clean other household items with. These cloths can retain dirt, grit, and chemical residues that may harm the acrylic. We recommend using a new or separate cloth for your acrylic care.

In case of scratches, do not worry. Unlike other materials, scratches on acrylic can be easily removed with specialty cleaning products, such as Novus (http://www.novuspolish.com). Keep your acrylic surfaces free from dust and dirt, with "Novus 1". It's a clear, anti-static formula specially created to easily remove the negative charge that can attract dust and dirt to the surface of acrylic. Or use "Novus 2" anti-static formula to remove surface scratches while it cleans. "Novus 3" is for removable of heavier scratches and requires Novus 2 for final finishing.

TO AVOID DANGEROUS GAPS, ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS BED SHALL BE A FULL-SIZE CRIB MATTRESS AT LEAST 51 5/8 IN. (1310 MM) IN LENGTH, 27 1/4 IN. (690 MM) IN WIDTH, AND A MAX THICKNESS OF 6 IN. (150 MM).

Parents should ensure a safe environment for the child by checking regularly, before placing the child in the product, that every component is properly and securely in place.

- Do not use this crib if you cannot exactly follow the accompanying instructions.
- Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow or comforter. Never place additional padding under an infant.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- Strangulation Hazard: Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.
- DO NOT place a crib near a window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- Fall Hazard: When a child is able to pull to a standing position, set the mattress to the lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- Do not use this crib if the child is able to climb out unaided or is taller than 35 in. (89cm).

- Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact Nursery Works for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- DO NOT use a water mattress with this crib.
- For cribs equipped with teething rails, replace teething rail if damaged, cracked or loose.
- If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic films as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides when used with a mattress that is too small.
- Follow warnings on all products in a crib.
- Ensure that the sides are properly latched or locked in place when the crib is occupied.
- The mattress used with this crib should not be more than 15cm thick and should be of such length with width that the gap between the mattress and the sides of the crib is no more than 3cm when the mattress is pushed into the corner of the crib.



Assembly Instructions


You will need two people to assemble this crib.

Step 1




Attach two Right Side Support Blocks 4 and 5 and two Left Side Support Blocks 6 and 7 to Headboards 1 by using Bolt B with Cap. Tighten all bolts with Allen wrench D.

- * Match the numbered labels on Support Blocks and Headboards.
- * Make sure all arrows are pointing up 1.




Place the Mattress Support Board ③ into the crib. Match the number labels on the Mattress Support Board and Support Blocks.

*Start at the highest position and adjust accordingly. As child grows, it is important to lower the Mattress Support.




Firmly attach the Mattress Support Board $\ \mathfrak{D}$ by inserting two Bolts $\ \mathfrak{C}$ with Caps at four corner holes.

Tighten all bolts with Allen wrench ${\bf D}.$




Assemble Side Rails (2) and Headboards (1) by using Bolt A.

^{*} Match the numbered labels on Side Rails, Headboards, Support Blocks and the Mattress Support Board.




Assembly is complete.
