Jennifer Chamandi

British footwear designer Jennifer Chamandi's ornate pieces are produced in the same Italian village where Manolo Blahnik and Christian Louboutin make their pieces, so you can expect a similar kind of impressive quality alongside the enchanting design. Above left is the **Vittorio heel**, a satin-designed slingback with crystals along the front, which seems like the perfect fit for a wedding.

Put simply, Jimmy Choo is footwear royalty, and when it comes to sourcing the perfect designer wedding shoes, the possibilities are endless. The brand also offers a bespoke online **Bridal Boutique**, where brides can opt for their new wedding shoes to feature a monogram on the sole, as their very own 'Something Blue' (see below).
