
#### Monitor Bracket Installation


 Remove the screw from monitor then take out the monitor. Place U type bracket in the installation location and mount with 3 screws.(see below pictures)






2. After screwing bracket in place, put the monitor into the bracket, adjust angle and lock it in place with thumb screws. (see below pictures)






3. Finish installation. The adjustable angle is forward 30  $^{\circ}$  and backward 30  $^{\circ}$ . (see below pictures)
