Inside of this activity book you will find many activities requiring adult help and/or supervision.



Instruction Guide

Parents/Teachers: The cutting out of some of these crafts/activity templates may be a bit tedious for smaller children. It is suggested that some elements (such as crown snowflakes) be cut out using an X-Acto knife or something similar, if you choose to be precise with details.

**PLEASE— X-Acto knife or other sharp knives are for adult use only. We do NOT recommend that children use these tools. Please use caution using such tools around children.

Activity 1: Make Your Own Ice Princess Crown

Photo Booklet Instructions:



*Cut out along the outer black line edges of each booklet page. Attach pages together using staples along the left side. Glue photos inside of booklet. You may use up to 4x6 photo.

Assembly Instructions:

*Cut out along the outer black line edges of the crown, snowflakes, and headband. Using a sharp knife, cut the opening slits to allow insertion of headband. Fit the crown to your child's size. Cut headband to fit, (cut extra length off of extra headband, if needed, and glue to headband to fit). DO NOT GLUE HEADBAND TO CROWN AT THIS POINT.

*Lay crown and headband flat onto newspapers. Spray crown and headband with adhesive spray. Sprinkle glitter all over crown and headband. Glue snowflakes to each point of the crown, at least half way in the middle of snowflake for durability. You may cover the jewel on the crown with the largest snowflake, or leave as is and decorate the jewel. Finish decorating the crown and headband.

*Attach headband to crown by slipping the headband into the previously cut out slits. Glue edges flat and securely onto crown.
