

Hailey bought 10 balloons for the New Year's party. 4 popped before the guests arrived. How many balloons were left?


Jordan brought 3 fireworks.

Hailey gave each guest 2 prizes. How many total prizes did she give? (Hint—use answer from 1st question to help you answer).


Colorful Math Balloons
