


Alabama State Symbols Interactive Foldable Booklets

You will find 2 booklets in this product. They are the SAME, except that one has color images, and one has black & white images so that you may choose which works best for your students and printer.






Assembly instructions: Cut out along the outer black line edges of each page. Stack so that the title page is on top and the pages get longer toward the back. Secure with staples at the top. Glue into your Interactive Notebook or Lapbook. **Completion Instructions:** State Map: Show where the capital and major cities are located. You may also want to show important waterways or landforms. State Flag: Write a statement about the state flag. State Flower: Write the name of the state flower. You may choose to write a statement about it as well. State Bird: Write the name of the state bird. You may choose to write a statement about it as well. State Mammal, Insect, or Fish (See explanation of this on previous page): Write the name of the mammal, insect, or fish. You may also choose to write a statement about it. Extra Page: You may write about any other state symbol you like. Add as many pages as you need.


