*Student Instructions: Glue the Snowcream Recipe inside the booklet. Make your own snowcream! (If you are in a warm climate dreaming about snow, use finely crushed ice.)

**Assembly Instructions: Cut booklet and recipe out around the outer black line edges. Fold booklet in half on the center vertical line. Glue recipe inside of booklet. Glue booklet into folder.
