Easy Placemats

This method is so easy! You will just need to sandwich your placemat top and the batting together. You can use safety pins or 505 spray to hold it together. Then cut your placemat backings 1" larger on all sides.

Placemats measure:

Placemat top Fabric cut to 18" x 14"

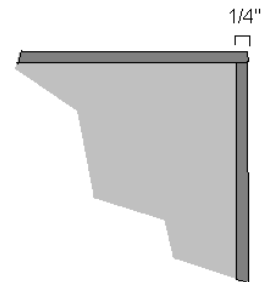
Placemat batting cut to 18" x 14"

Placemat backing cut to 20" x 16"

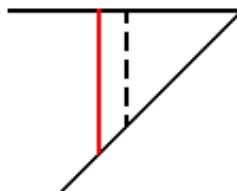
If you choose to embellish your placemat, quilt, decorative stitch or embroider the top and batting only.

Prepare the Backing Fabric:

1. On all sides of the backing fabric fold edges $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press in place.
2. On each corner draw a line 1" from the corner.
3. Fold in half diagonally and sew on the drawn line. Trim and flip.
4. This creates an envelope for your quilt top and batting.



Sew on the red line.
Trim on the dotted line.



Flip the 4 corners inside out. Insert top and batting. Top stitch along the folded edge.
