Fat Quarter Club: June 2022










The CUTTING

- From Each of the 5 colors
 - 4, 4" x 2 ¼" Rectangles
- From the White
 - 4, 1 ½" x 9 ½" Rectangles
 - 40, 2 ¼" squares
- From leftover fat Quarters
 - 4, 2 ¼" x Width of Fat Quarter
- From leftover Fat Quarter
 - 2, 9 ½" Squares



The Piecing

- Make the flying geese units (total 20 for 2 potholders)
 - Draw lines on the wrong side of the 40, 2 ¼" white squares
 - Press (do not cut extra white fabric from triangles)
- Sew these flying geese units together according to the video
- Sew the 1 ½" strips of white on to both sides of the flying geese blocks
- Make 2





The Quilting


- Attach #1D foot or a walking foot with a guide set to ~3/4" away from the needle
- Quilt across the potholder, remembering to select Pattern End each time you start a new row
- Use a serpentine stitch (we used stitch #1398)





The Binding

- Trip the excess batting and backing away and square up your potholders.
- Sew your 2 ¼" strips together and press in half longwise
- Attach the #71 Foot
- Starting at a corner on the wrong side of the potholder, stitch, using the side of the #71 foot as a seam guide
- Miter each corner according to the video
- Press
