## Supplies

Fat Quarter Club Kit
Sewing machine with a $1 / 4$ " foot

- We used BERNINA \#57

Mini Stripology Ruler
Rotary Cutter Mat and Rulers
Aurifil Sewing Thread
Bottom Line Thread
Isacord Thread

Scrap Batting
Iron

- We used Laurastar Smart U

Size 90 Quilting Needle - for quilting
Size 80 Universal needle - for piecing

Magic Pins

## Cutting

Reserve two fat quarters (for border, backing and binding)

## 3-2" Strips Width of Fat Quarter (WoFQ)



Tiny Cherrys

## Sub Cutting

From Each 2" strip

- 1-20" piece (yield 10, $2^{\prime \prime}$ subcuts)
- 1-12" piece (yield 6, 2" subcuts)
- $2-8$ " pieces (yield $4,2^{\prime \prime}$ subcuts each)



## Sewing the Strips Together

It is important to follow the sewing order for the strips:

Set 1: 20" pieces

Set 2: 12" pieces

## Set 3: 8" pieces



Set 4: 8" pieces


## Subcut the Sewn Strips

Refer to the diagram at the right
Use the Mini Stripology ruler to make the 2" subcuts

## Assemble 4 Blocks

- Measures 8 12"
- Follow the layout on the right
- Use Magic Pins to ensure that the seams line up



## Assemble Side Units

- 3 Rows
- Assembled like previous block
- Press seams open
- Make 2



## Additional Cutting

- 2-2" mint squares
- 1-2" mini Cherry
- 4-1" strips of reserved Dark Green Mini Cherries
- 4-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of reserved Dark Green Mini Cherries
- 4-2" strips of border of your choice



## Assemble the Quilt

Sew a mint 2" square to the mini cherry 2" square and then sew the other mint 2" square to that.
Like assembling a nine patch, use the diagram to the right to construct the quilt body

Add the $1^{\prime \prime}$ dark green strips for border one, starting on each side, then adding the top and bottom

Repeat for the second border


## QUILTING

Use Mock-Hand Quilting Stitch \#1304 (BERNINA 4, 5 Series) or \#1328 (BERNINA 7 and 8 Series)

This stitch is also available on may other BERNINA Machines and is represented by this icon


I didn't have to make any changes, but you may need to increase (higher number) or decrease (lower number) the thread tension.
