# BOWL COZY SPECIFIC **SUPPLIES**


We're covering several tools to make a bowl cozy. You will certainly discover your favorite method amongst these choices:

- Large, Small or Dinner Plate Pre-cut **Bowl Cozy Batting**
- Jelly Roll Bowl Cozy Template
- Non-Slip Bowl Cozy Template Set
- Pellon Wrap-n-Zap by the Yard











- If you wish for your finished bowl cozies to be microwaved, you will need to use 100% cotton materials.
  - The Pre-Cut Batting and Wrap-n-Zap are specifically designed for this purpose
  - Our Fat Quarters in this month's kit are 100% cotton
  - Your thread needs to be 100% cotton. We used
    - 60wt Mettler Silk Finish
    - 50wt Aurifil 100% cotton thread
    - 12wt cotton Aurifil Thread (used in the serger)
  - Needle
    - Size 75 Quilting Needle

#### THREAD SELECTIONS





- Option 1: Walking Foot with left and right seam guides
- Option 2: Embroidery module and quilting design
- Option 3: Jelly Roll Inspired
- Option 4: Coverstitch serger
- Additional Sewing Feet
  - Patchwork feet #37D, #97D for sewing darts and bowl outside to bowl lining
- Optional Hoop if you choose to embroider
  - Medium Square Clamp

#### **General Notions:**

- Water Soluble Marking Pen
- Water-Soluble Stabilizer if embroidering/quilting
- Rotary Cutter Mat and Ruler
- Fabric clips or straight pins

## MACHINE SUPPLIES AND OTHER NOTIONS

### #1 - WALKING FOOT OPTION


#### LARGE AND SMALL PRE-CUT BATTING

- Choosing the pre-cut batting package of your choice
- Layer a fat quarter facing wrong side up and the pre-cut batting on top
  - For Large bowl, cut a 16" square
  - For a small bowl, cut a 9" square
- Bowls are made from 2 fabric squares and 2 pre-cut batting pieces




## #1 - WALKING FOOT OPTION

- Attach the walking foot and guide set to your desired width
  - We used 1 ½"
- Thread machine with Aurifil 50 wt thread in top and bottom
- Select Stitch #1 and set the length to 3.5mm
- Turn the work so that the fabric is on top (pretty side)
- Stitch in rows vertically and horizontally until work is covered
- Make 2



## #1 - WALKING FOOT OPTION


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### #2 – EMBROIDERY OPTION

#### Attach your embroidery module

- Layer items as with walking foot
- Choose a quilting design
- Thread your machine with 60wt cotton thread in top and bottom
- Hoop one layer of Aquamesh Stabilizer in the Hoop
- Use a basting function to hold your work steadily in the hoop for quilting
- Make 2



# #3 – JELLY ROLL INSPIRED

Select some of your fat quarters and cut into 2 ½" strips (by at least 9" long for short bowl and 16" long for large bowl)


- Choose a pre-cut batting piece
  - Use the Jelly Roll Bowl Cozy Template to mark your lives and darts
    - With the water-soluble marking pen
  - You could also use this template to cut your own wrap-n-zap and mark your darts
- This will be your foundation for stitch and flip
  - Start at the bottom and work your way up
  - Mark darts when the batting is covered and cut on this line afterwards (all 4 sides)
- Make 2



# #4 – QUILTED BY COVERSTITCH

Set up your Coverstitch Serger for a 2 Thread Chain stitch


- Attach foot #C or L23 (BERNINA L 8 Series Overlockers only)
- Thread with Aurifil 50wt 100% cotton through the needle
- Thread the Coverstitch looper with 12wt Aurifil thread
- Set your presser foot tension to 2
- Turn the batting to the top side you will be working upside down so that the looper thread is your decorative stitch
- Quilt with a meandering chain stitch
- Make 2



### **SEWING DARTS**

No Matter the technique you chose, the bowls will be stitched together the same way

- Stitch darts by lining up the raw edges and stitch ¼"- 3 1/8"
  - Accuracy is not as important as consistency
  - BERNINA Machines without dual feed should use the walking foot
  - BERNINA Dual Feed machines, use #37D or #97D patchwork feet



### FINAL CONSTRUCTION

Press Darts Open and insert the top side of a bowl, right sides together with the bottom sides.

Leave an opening for turning

Stitch (1/4" - 3/8") is fine) just be consistent

Clip corners and turn inside out

Press

Top stich around the bowl to close the open seam




#### **IMPORTANT DETAILS**

#### On the Embroidered Blocks

 If you used water-soluble stabilizer, you must wash the bowl completely to remove the water-soluble stabilizer

#### Cutting your own templates

- You can use a Creative Grid Grippy ruler (Non-Slip Bowl Cozy Template Set) to cut your own wrap-n-zap and fabric
  - This allows you to only use one layer of batting because the wrap and zap is just a little bit thicker than one layer of the pre-cut batting
