



# Bunny Silhouette Mug Rug



 Fold (2) Back Fabric pieces in half widthwise, wrong sides together, and press well.



 Iron Fusible Backing to the wrong side of the Background 1, Bunny 1, and Bunny 3 Fabrics.



• Load the embroidery file into the machine.






#### **EMBROIDERY MACHINE SET-UP**

- We used a BERNINA 880 PLUS machine with a (Maxi Hoop) maximum hoop size of ~8" x 15"
- There are 2 "Mug Rug" hoop options, if you are using the BERNINA Large Hoop, you can use the small design only
- The Large Mug Rug design is a wee bit too large for the Maxi Hoop so we reduced the file by 2%
  - On a BERNINA 880 with the Jumbo Hoop there is no need to reduce your file.
- This design is a one hoop project
- Load OESD Bobbinfil in the bobbin
- Follow Kimberbell and our <u>Video Instructions</u> for thread sequencing



 Hoop the Medium Cut-Away Stabilizer.




Stitch the Batting Placement
 Line directly onto the stabilizer.




Place the Project Batting.

Stitch the Mug Rug Template. Do not trim the batting at this time.



• Place the Background 1 Fabric **right side up**, completely covering section 1.






Stitch the Trimming/Placement Line.

• Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.



 Place the Background 2 Fabric right side down, with one long edge centered along the stitch line.




# Stitch the Seam.



**side up** and press the seam.


• **Tip:** Use a mini iron or finger press along the seam line. If you are using an iron, remove the hoop from the machine and press on an ironing board.





• Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.















 Place the Bunny 2 Leather right side up.




 Place Wash-Away Topping, completely covering the leather.

• Trim the leather and topping close to the stitch line. Do not remove the remaining topping over the bunny at this time.



Stitch the Bunny 2 DecorativeOutline.





Stitch the Bunny 3 Placement Line.



 Place the Bunny 3 Fabric right side up.



- Stitch the Bunny3 Tack-downLine.
- Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.

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


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




Stitch "Happy Easter".

#### SAME INSTRUCTIONS for Larger File



 Place (2) Back Fabric pieces on top of the project, with folded edges toward the center, and overlapping about 1". Be sure the entire box previously sewn is covered.




- Place tape over the entire exposed fold to prevent the machine foot from catching on the fabric.
- Tape the corners in place.


#### SAME INSTRUCTIONS for Larger File



Stitch the FinalOutline.



- Remove the project from the hoop.
- Remove all tape.
- Trim all layers, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.



- Clip corners to reduce bulk.
- Trim across the corner seam allowance, being careful not to cut through the stitches.
- Trim again at a slight angle, from the corner up the seam allowance, about 1" on each side to reduce bulk.



- Turn the project right side out. Poke the corners with a blunt tip to square.
- Tear away any excess topping. Remove any remaining topping with a wet cotton swab or cotton ball.
- Using a pressing cloth, press well.
