Romantic take on Elizabeth Hartman's Lana Lemur



SUPPLIES

- [Lemurs in Love kit](#) from BERNINA of Naperville
- Sewing machine with ¼” foot, Open Toe foot for applique and Free-Motion foot for puffy batting
 - For piecing we used the BERNINA #97D foot on our BERNINA 880 Plus
 - For applique we used the #20D foot. Alternatively you could use the #20 for 5.5mm machines, #20C for 9mm machines without dual feed.
 - For quilting we used the BERNINA Stitch Regulator with the echo quilting wide plastic base. Alternatively: BERNINA #74 Adjustable Cup Clip Foot, #44, #43
- Thread
 - Piecing and Quilting: 100% Cotton 50wt thread from Aurifil
 - Applique: YLI Smoke Monofilament .004 mm
 - Needle: Microtext size 70

- [Apliquick Tools](#)

- Scissors
- Rods
- Glue

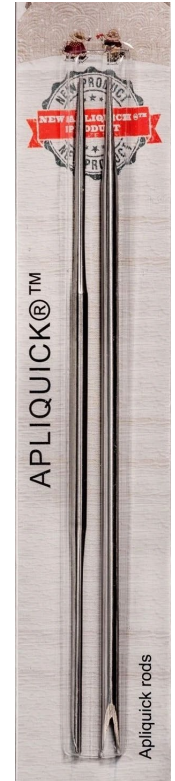
- [Dream Puff Batting: 36" x 45"](#)

- Backing to measure 36" x 45"

- ½ Yard of binding

- [Quilting Gloves](#)

- [8" square of Apliquick interfacing](#) or alternatively an 8" square of freezer paper

Lana Lemur Pattern

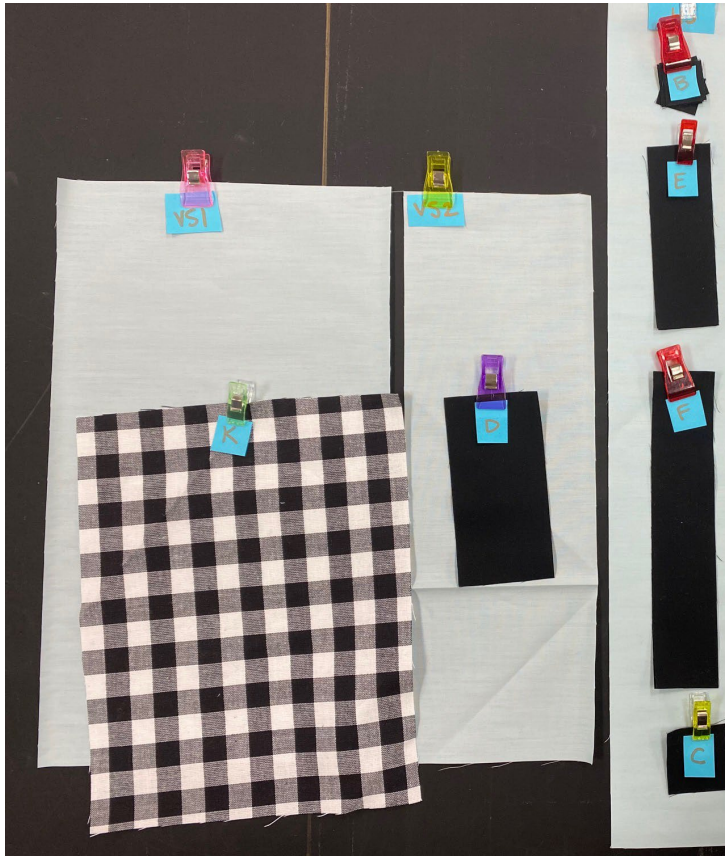
Fabric

- Lemurs: 2 - 10" Squares each of Gray & Black
 - Make sure to make inverse colorways of each lemur like our cuties on the right
 - See how they compliment each other?
- White Grunge for faces and tails
- Gray Polkadot scrap for inner ears
- Red scrap for heart
- Liberty of London peacock print for "fussy" cut eyes

Use as a labeling chart for intricately pieced patterns.

- Like any Elizabeth Hartman Pattern, you need to label, label, label to keep everything straight!
- We designed a labeling chart to print so you do not have to hand write everything.
- Just print and cutout and use fabric clips to keep your pieces straight

FUSSY CUTTING

- When you cut out the Merci Paris Architecture background fabric – be sure to keep everything that is a large black right side up!
- From the Liberty of London Peacock fabric cut the eyes...



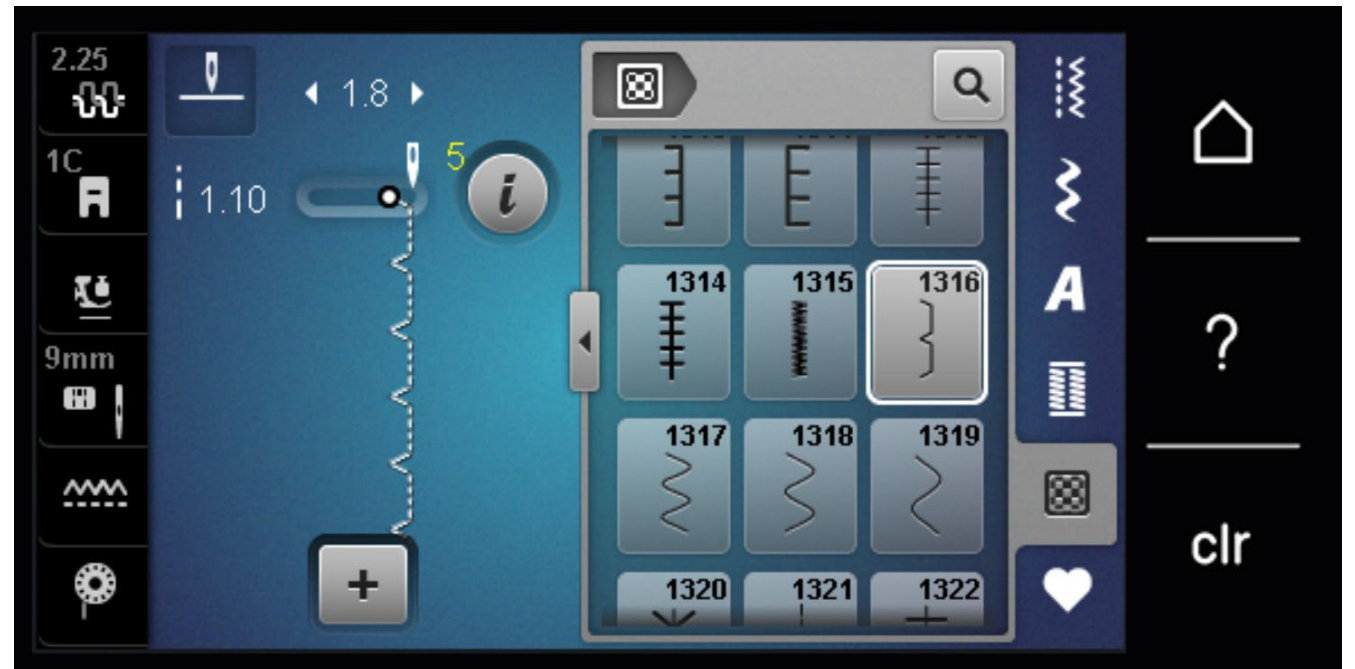


APPLIQUE with APLIQUICK®

Apliquick tools are perfect for intricate
needle-turn applique like we did with the
heart.

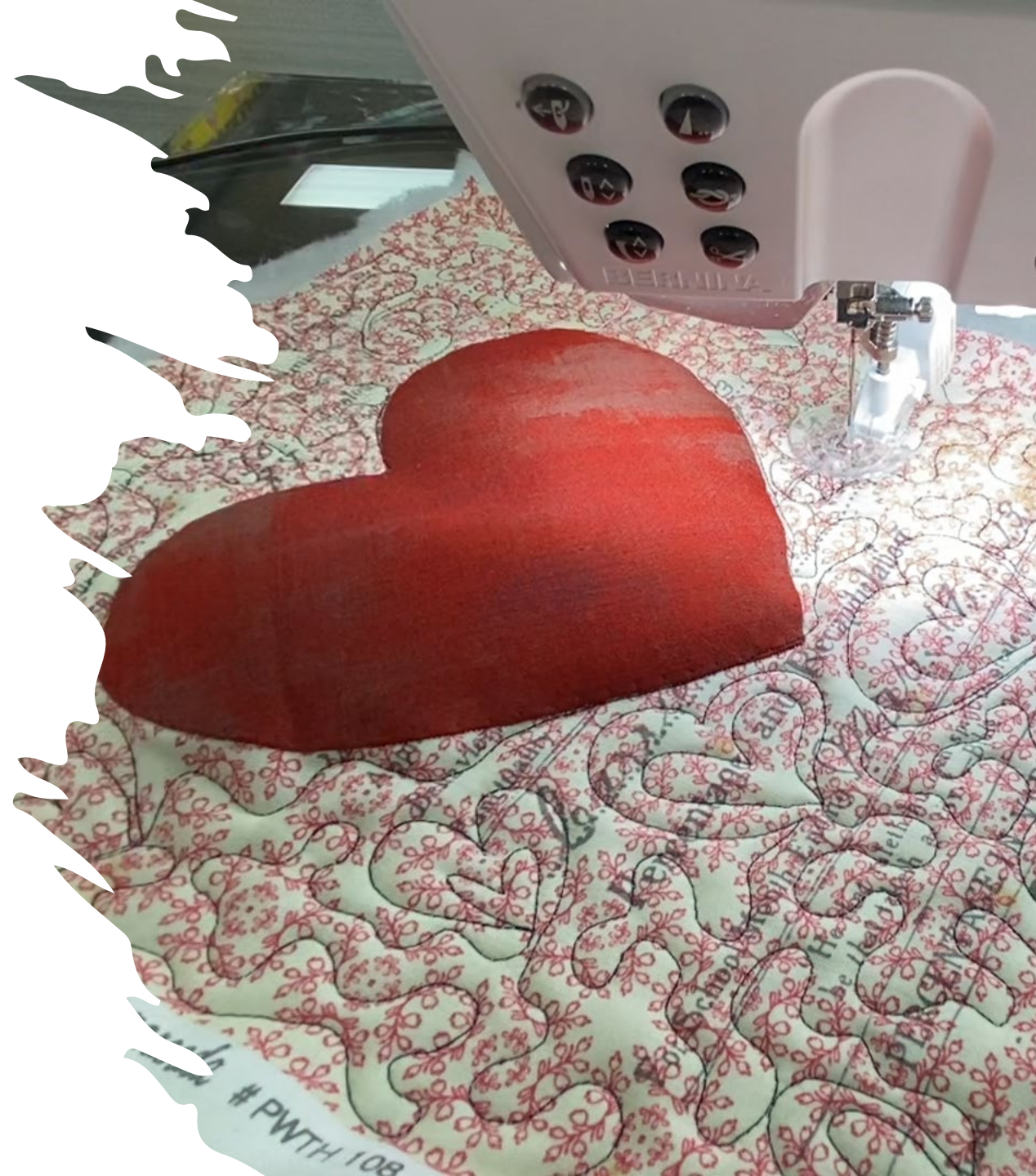
MACHINE APPLIQUE SET- UP

- Select the blind hem stitch or the invisible machine applique stitch
 - If using #9 Blind hem stitch, adjust stitch width to 1.8mm and stitch length to 1.1mm
- Use and open toe embroidery foot
 - #20D, #20C or #20
 - Alternatively, you could use a clear foot #39 or #39C or even #34, #34C or #34D



QUILTING

- Try a new free-motion pattern like hearts and meandering
- Definition
 - Meandering VS Stipple
 - Meandering = Large Stipple
 - Stipple = Wormy lines that create texture in a quilting background. Lines should not cross over or form points
- Layer the 1005 cotton backing Dream Puff Polyester batting from Quilter's Dream and you Lemurs (after you applique the heart)
