Supplies

Penguin Party

- <u>Penguin Party Kit from BERNINA of Naperville</u>
- Sewing Machine with ¼ " foot and free-motion foot
 - Recommended Freemotion Presser Feet
 - **#44C**, **#43**, **#74**
 - Or BERNINA Stitch regulator with clear plastic sole
- Mettler Silk Finish 100% cotton thread in 50wt for sewing and piecing
- 20" Square of batting




Penguin Party

Fabric



- Scrap for beak
- 4, 10" squares for Penguin body choose one
- 3/8 Yard for background
- ¹/₂ Yard of lux cuddle for backing

You add 20" square batting for quilting baby snuggle









Penguin Party Making a fuzzy binding from the backing material

- No matter the quilting method you choose, trim the batting flush with the pieced quilt top
- Trim the cuddle approximately 2 1/4" away from the batting and pieced quilt top
- Fold the fur's raw edge to the edge of the quilt top, then fold again over the quilt top
- Stitch on the machine with a #4 serpentine stitch
 - Stitch Length = 2.0mm
 - Stitch Width = 5.0mm
