- Instructions include additional fabric requirements to make this a crib-sized quilt

## THE FABRICS

5 Selections from Heather Ross's Forestburgh and 1 Art Gallery Fabrics Pure Solid

FORESTBURGH: Clover-Rust FORESTBURGH: Firefly-Spruce FORESTBURGH: Broadstripe-Green FORESTBURGH: Beargrass-Blush FORESTBURGH: Night Music-Mauve Pure Solids in Sweet Mint


## THE SUPPLIES

Batting: 13" x 18"
$1 / 2$ Yard Fusible Web
Thread:

- Seralene for quilting
- Isacord tor Appliqué
- Cotton 50wt for binding construction to match binding
Sharp Scissors for easily fussy cutting fabric 505 Glue Stick
Iron
Rotary Cutter Mat and Ruler Printer with paper


## TEMPLATES

Download Templates Here and then print

- Follow the instructions on the templates
- You will be tracing the templates onto the paper side of the fusible Web
- We printed then cut our templates out perfectly online the line
- This technique allowed for us to mirror certain pieces
- Keep the stripe fabric and Lightning Bug fabric on hand for this step
- Strip fabric
- Determine how you want your stripes to run
- Consider drawing the directions of the lines on your template


From the Orange Clover Fabric Cut $1-4^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2$ " Strip

- This piece is large enough for you to fussy cut.
- Divide this piece in half by trimming along the
clover line and creating a rough looking edge. This

Divide this piece in half by trimming along the
clover line and creating a rough looking edge. This will be the bottom piece.

- Neaten the bottom of the remaining strip by
cutting along the shape of the clover. This is the top piece. Set aside.


## From the Mauve Fabric

Cut 1-Triangle template choosing your favorite musical critters

Cut as many as you would like - critters from the fabric - We chose the Moon

From the Pink Animal fabric
Cut as many as you would like

- We chose the deer, the bear and the chipmunk


## FUSSY CUTTING



## CUTTING

From the Remainder Clover Fabric

- Cut $2-3^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strips for sides
- Cut $2 \frac{1}{1 / 4}$ " strips for binding

From the Mint Fabric

- Cut 1-13" square

From the Remainder of the lightning bug fabric

- Cut 1-14" $\times 18^{\prime \prime}$ Piece for Backing



## ASSEMBLY

With right sides together, stitch a Striped Tent Flap to a Firefly Tent Flap (make 2).

- Leave an opening along the long-angled side for turning
- Trim corner, turn right side out, and press



## ASSEMBLY

Peel the fusible web paper from the Main Tent and Inside Tent Pieces

- Place on the $13^{\prime \prime}$ Square so that it looks rather centered
- Do not press down until you tuck the Inside Tent and the Right Tent Flap piece under the main tent piece

Place a $13^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{\prime \prime}$ Piece of heavy weight tear away stabilizer under the background fabric

Set your machine for a single blanket stitch \#1329 or \#1309

- Adjust stitch to your liking
- We used 3 mm stitch width, 3 mm stitch length with needle position all of the way to the right

Applique around the main tent, bottom of the inside tent and left side of the inside tent


## ASSEMBLY

## Add the left Tent Flap -

- Tuck the seam allowance in so that there are no raw edges exposed.
- Applique the left side only with the blanket stitch



## ASSEMBLY

Add the Top and Bottom clover pieces

- Using the 505 Stick, Temporarily adhere these into position



## ASSEMBLY

Add the Top and Bottom clover pieces

- Using the 505 Stick, Temporarily adhere these into position
- Be creative - anything goes, because it is YOUR imagination
- Once you get your critters into position, adhere them with the 505 stick

We will be appliqueing them in the quilting step.


## BORDERS

Remove tear away stabilizer
Trim you block to $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
Attach a $3^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strip to each side of your block

Press and Sandwich with the backing, and batting


## QUILTING

Machine Set-up

- Stitch \#1 with the feed dogs dropped
- Foot \#24 - Open toe to see where we are going
- BERNINA Longarmers: Foot \#24 is a lesser expensive alternative to the \#73 Adjustable Open Toe foot.
- Get25\% off the \#24 Foot
- USE CODE: 25OFF24 Get25\% off the \#24 Foot
- Alternatively, you may wish to use the BERNINA Stitch Regulator

Now free motion applique and quilt until you heart is content.
