## **About the Skindiver Special Edition**

The popularity of of slim, light and dressy dive watches, called "skin divers", can be traced back to the late 1950s. With the Skindiver Special Edition, we've incorporated key design cues from skin divers of times past into a modern and refined timepiece that's powered by a reliable and accurate guartz movement.

Case: Stainless steel, plated, diameter 40mm


Crystal: K1 hardened mineral, double domed, anti-reflective

Dial: Multi-layer, with luminous hands and markers

Movement: Quartz, made in Japan

Functions: Hour, minute, second, elapsed time

Water resistance: 100m/ 330ft/ 10ATM



# **Setting the Time**

- Pull crown out to Position B.

Timepiece will stop running – seconds hand (1) will stop moving.

- Turn the crown to set the time, then push crown back to Position A.

Timepiece will start running again.

## **Measuring Elapsed Time**

- The timing bezel can be rotated in an anticlockwise direction only.
- Rotate the bezel and align the zero mark ( $\blacktriangledown$ ) to the minute hand. You can then tell the elapsed time by reading the position on the bezel that the minute hand is pointing at.

#### **General Care**

- Don't wear your timepiece while jet-skiing or scuba diving.
- Steam and vapour can penetrate the case and damage your timepiece. Don't expose it to temperature extremes or corrosive chemicals, or wear it in saunas.
- Don't place your timepiece near loudspeakers or other equipment that generate strong magnetic fields, as timepiece precision may be affected.

## **Battery Changes & Aftersales Support**

- When the second hand starts moving irregularly, it's time to replace the battery. Bring the timepiece to any reliable watchmaker.
