

## My Favourite Colour is Moda BOM Block 16



Note: circled numbers refers to whole block as one piece.



Numbers in pink refer to fabric number on swatch chart for your colourway.









Make piles of the fabrics being paired up, fabrics 1 and 3, fabrics 2 and 8 and fabrics 4 and 8. Mark a diagonal line on the lightest of each pair.

Starting with the larger squares fabrics 1 and 3, sew a 1/4" seam either side of the diagonal line for each pair. You should have 2













Now do the same for the smaller pairs of fabrics 2 and 8 and 4 and 8. You should have 4 of each.

Cut apart on the diagonal line to create 4 HSTs of fabric 1 and 3, and 8 each of fabrics 2 and 8 and 4 and 8.














Square each HST for fabric 1 and 3 to 5". You should now have 4 of these.

Square each of the smaller HSTs to 2 3/4" you should now have 8 of each colour way.










Press towards the darker fabric for each HST.











Lay out the bears paw design keep a close eye on those claws... they have a habit of flipping around! Sew together 2 of the fabric 4 and 8 HSTs using a 1/4" seam and press towards darker fabric.

Now sew the remaining 2 HSTs and the corner square together to make a strip. Press each seam towards the darker fabric.













Sew the 2 piece block onto the right edge of the larger HST, then press.













Now add the final row to the bottom of the block, again using a 1/4" seam making sure any seams nest together and then press. Trim your block to ensure it is square at  $6\,3/4$ ".



Repeat to make 2 identical units.







As before lay out the alternate colour way bears paw. This time you have fabrics 3 and 8 for the smaller HSTs. Keep a close eye on the orientation of the claws!

Sew the two side HSTs together with a 1/4" seam and press to the dark side.

Create the bottom strip by sewing two HSTs together and adding a corner square. Press to the darker fabric.
















Join each of the strips onto the larger HST pressing each seam in between.

Make sure that your seams nest together.












Press the block flat.



Repeat to make a second identical unit.



Cut the square of fabric 5 diagonally in both directions to create 4 triangles. Repeat to make 8 in total.



Repeat for fabrics 6 and 8.









To create the 1/4 square triangles sew together a triangle of fabric 8 and a triangle of fabric 6. Repeat to create 4 of these. Take care not to stretch these as you are working on the bias. Press each towards the darker fabric.

Now sew together a triangle of fabrics 5 and 6, repeat to make 4. Press each towards the dark side.


















Lay out your blocks, checking the orientation. Nest the centre seams together and sew a 1/4" seam to join the quarter squares triangles together. Press each block open. Repeat to create 4 identical hourglasses.







Square your blocks to 5". We have used the clearly perfect slotted trimmer for this but use the method of your choice.









Sew the rectangle of fabric 8 to the triangle of fabric 8 and press flat. Repeat for all 4 units.

Sew one unit to each side of the centre square of fabric 7 using 1/4" seam. Press towards the centre.











Now sew one of each colour way of the bears paw blocks to either side of the hourglass units. Nest the seams each time.

Repeat to create both sets. Press the seams towards the bears paw blocks.







Lay out your strip sets. Check the orientation carefully before moving on.











Nest the seams and join the top and bottom to the centre strip set.

Press the block once finished.
