### Scenario 11.1

#### MORNING ATTACK ON SHERMAN'S DIVISION

Shiloh, Tennessee - 7:00 am, April 6th 1862

The 3rd Brigade of Brig. Gen. Daniel Ruggles' Division, CSA (under Col. Preston Pond) and the 3rd Brigade of Brig. Gen. Jones Withers' division (under Brig. Gen. John R. Jackson) had moved under cover of the pre-dawn into the woods near Shiloh creek and into assault positions. Around 7am Confederate skirmishers came within 50 yards of division commander Brig. General William T. Sherman (USA) as he gazed across the field with his field glasses.

The brazen Confederate skirmishers let loose a volley that killed his orderly and wounded Sherman in his hand. Sherman rode off with all haste to organize his defenses as the Confederate Brigades of Pond and Johnson emerged from the woods near Shiloh Creek.

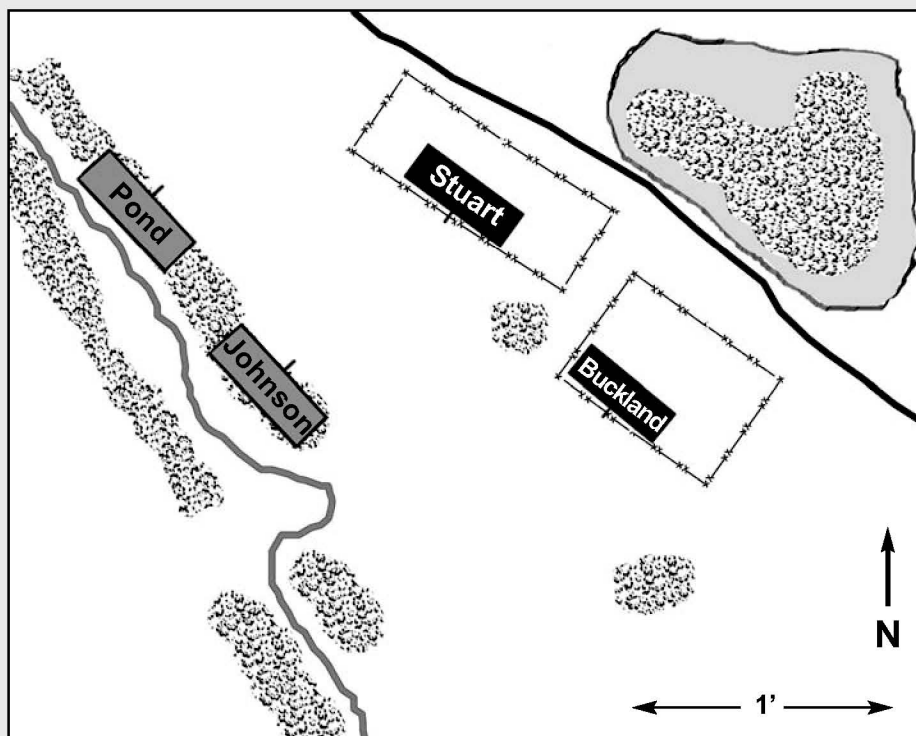
The Union Brigades of Col. David Stuart and Col. Ralph P. Buckland under the personal direction of Sherman quickly took up positions south of Purdy Road and prepared to defend against the surprise Confederate attack.

The fighting was sharp and fierce as the momentum of the Confederates carried the Union line forcing the Union Brigades to withdraw north across the road. The withdrawal quickly turned into a rout as the Confederates pursued, capturing many prisoners and even overrunning Sherman's camp.

**GAME LENGTH: 18 TURNS**

#### VICTORY CONDITIONS:

The side that drives the enemy from the field of battle first wins the scenario. When a side has 60% of their stands broken or casualties that side is considered to have been driven from the field. Any other result is considered an inconclusive draw.

#### **Deployment:**

1. The Union Brigades deploy as shown on the map. After set-up, each Union regiment must make a cohesion check. If they fail they are placed in disorder. This simulates the confusion and haste in which Sherman organized his defense.
2. Sherman may begin the scenario with either brigade.

**Set-up Rules:** The Orleans Gd Batt. can be combined with any other infantry regiment in Pond's Brigade at the beginning of the scenario.

**Note:** In this assault, the Confederates used the 3rd Brigade from the 1st Division and the 3rd Brigade from the 2nd Division - hence two 3rd Brigades.

**Deployment:** All units begin the scenario on the edge of the woods in any formation the Confederate commander chooses. The artillery is unlimbered.
