THE COLLAPSE OF THE JOHNSON'S RESERVE Murfreesboro, Tennessee - Early Morning, December 31st, 1862

Just after dawn the Confederate brigades of Maj. Gen. J. P. McCown's division had hit the Union right flank hard. By 7:30 the Union flank was on the verge of complete collapse. Confederate brigades under the command of Brig. Gen. St. John R. Liddell (CSA) and Brig. Gen. Evander McNair (CSA) were sent in to break the remaining Union brigades and force a complete collapse of the Union right flank. With great élan, the Confederates quickly closed the distance and engaged the Union soldiers at ranges as close as 25 yards. Standing toe to toe both sides showed great courage as they exchanged volleys.

The steady fire of the Confederates took its toll upon the Union soldiers. The 3rd Brigade under Col. Philoemon P. Baldwin (USA) began to fall back into the woods. The 93rd Ohio stood firm until it's commander was given a direct order by Baldwin to withdraw.

As the soldiers of the 1st Arkansas surged over the split rain fence in pursuit of the fleeing Union

VICTORY CONDITIONS:


The side that drives the enemy from the field of battle first wins the scenario. When a side has 60% of their stands broken or casualties that side is considered to have been driven from the field. Any other result is considered an inconclusive draw.

soldiers, the regimental color bearer exclaimed "Boys, this is fun!" Twenty minutes later his arm was shattered by a Union minie ball.

Meanwhile, the 2nd Brigade under Col. Joseph B. Dodge (USA) quickly did an about face and attempted to form a line. Under hard pressure from the Confederates, his brigade was also forced back into the woods to the north with McNair's Arkansas soldiers in hot pursuit.

The Union right flank at Stones River - not from lack of courage - would collapse this cold December morning.
