

#### Size chart: Rings

- Take a ring that perfectly fits your finger.
- Place it over the nearest sized circle of the Ring Size Chart.
- The inner edge of the ring has to be aligned with the outer edge of the circle.
- If your ring appears to be between two sizes, we recommend that you chose the larger size.






# Measure a ring of your own

#### Print the ring size chart:

- To get the correct results, you will need to go the "printing settings" before printing and ensure that the "page scaling" option is set to "none" in the print dialogue box.
- Print the ring size chart on a A4 size page.
- To check that the ring size chart has been printed properly, take a ruler and measure the sample below. It should measure exactly 2 cm.



The inner edge of the ring is aligned with the outer edge of the circle.
