lets get crafty with crochet!

Welcome to the pattern sheet for your Strawberry Pot crochet kit. The purpose of this pattern is so that you have a PDF version of your crochet instructions to supplement your online guide. This can be handy if you're not a crochet newbie or if you've mastered the video tutorials and would now like to work on your own.

Pieces to Complete

To complete your Strawberry Pot you'll be crocheting a range of elements separately and assembling them together at the end.

- 1x Pot w/ optional lace detail
- 1x Bow or heart detail
- 1x Soil
- 3x Strawberries
 - $\circ~$ Stitched in red, pink and cream
- 3x Calyx leaves
- 4x Large leaves on wire
- 4x Small leaves on wire
- 4x Flower petals
- 4x Flower middles

Optional Lace Details

You can add this lace detail in any colour you'd like, but we recommend the cream yarn followed by the pink yarn.

- Tie on cream, ch2 to begin
- Round 20: (sc, 2ch, skip next stitch) x27, 2ch, sl st to finish round
- Tie on pink, ch2 to begin
- Round 21: (sc into 2ch sp in previous round, ch3) x27, 3ch, sl st tp finish round)

Heart or Bow Details

You have the option to add a heart or bow to the front of your Strawberry Pot to decorate your design. We recommend watching the video guide when learning to slip stitch the heart on your pot.

Heart	• Use slip stitches to create the heart shape on the
	front of the pot.

Bow

- Chain 50-55 stitches to create a rope.
- Tie this rope into a bow and attach with your weaving needle or hot glue gun.
- You can also use slip stitches to create a ring around your pot under the ribbon to give the effect of a bow tied around the pot.

Dark Brown Soil

- Round 1: 8sc into magic ring [8] • Round 2: 8inc [16] • Round 3: (sc, inc) x8 [24] [32]
- Round 4: sc, inc, (2sc, inc) x7, sc
- Round 5: (3sc, inc) x8
- Round 6: 2sc, inc, (4sc, inc) x7, 2sc
- Round 7: (inc, 5sc) x8

Strawberries

Create 3x of these strawberries in your red, pink and cream yarn.

- Round 1: 6sc into magic ring [6]
 Round 2: (sc, inc) x3 [9]
- Round 3: (2sc, inc) x3 [12]
- Round 4: sc, inc, (2sc, inc) x3), sc [16]
- Round 5: 16sc
- Round 6: (inc, 3sc) x4 [20]
- Round 7: 2sc, inc, (4sc, inc) x3, 2sc [24]
- Round 8: 24sc
- Round 9: (dec, 4sc) x4 [20]
- Round 10: 10dec or as many as needed to close the strawberry, stuff as you go

Use your weaving needle to add the strawberry seeds after your strawberry shape is complete and stuffed. You will weave throughout the whole strawberry, the polyfill stuffing will help to hold the seeds in place. You can use any colours you like for the seeds but we recommend using contrasting colours.

Strawberry Calyx

- Round 1: 6sc into magic ring, sl st to closr the round
- Round 2: (8ch, sl st into the next stitch) x5, for the last section, sl st into the first chain of your first 8ch so there is no gap between the leaves

Watch our video tutorials to see how you'll attach your strawberries to your green calyx and wires. You can sew down the corners of the leaves if you want them to sit flat on your strawberry. Or ditch the sewing to have a spikier effect on top.

Smaller Leaves

Create 4x of these smaller leaves, working into the wire for your first round

- Foundation: 10ch
- Round 1 First Side: Skip 1st chain, sc, hdc, 5dc, hdc
- Round 1 Leaf Tip: 3hdc into the last chain
- Round 1 **Second Side**: hdc, 5dc, hdc, sc, sl st to close the round
- Round 2: (2ch, sc) x26, sl st to close the round

Larger Leaves

Create 4x of these larger leaves, working into the wire for your first round

- Foundation: 13ch
- Round 1 **First Side**: Skip 1st chain, sc, 2hdc, 6dc, 2hdc
- Round 1 Leaf Tip: 3hdc into the last chain
- Round 1 **Second Side**: 2hdc, 6dc, 2hdc, sc, sl st to close the round
- Round 2: (2ch, sc) x32, sl st to close the round

White Flower Petals & Yellow Middles

Create 4x of the white petals and 4x of the yellow middles

- Petals
- Round 1: 6sc into magic ring, sl st to close the round
 - Round 2: (*2ch, 2dc* into the same stitch) x5, sl st into the last chain of the first petal to close the round without leaving a gap

Middle • Round 1: 6sc into magic ring, sl st to close the round

To assemble your Strawberry Pot you will need a hot glue gun. We recommend watching the video tutorial to see the assembling process visually as it can seem complicated when written down!

First you'll want to weave in all the ends of your yarn using your weaving needle. Then you will attach the thicker wires to your strawberries and flowers. Next you'll want to attach your leaves to your strawberry and flower stems – this can be done in any order. When you're happy with the leaves on each stem, you'll wrap the wires so they're completely covered with sage green yarn. Wrap both the main stem as well as the leaves.

Once your stems are ready, its time to assemble them in your pot! You'll be bundling them together and pushing them through the middle of your dark brown soil. Bend the ends of your stems outwards to allow them to sit nicely, and start stuffing your pot with the polyfill stuffing – this will help provide structure and hold up your stems.

When you're happy with the position of your stems, you'll use your weaving needle to stitch the edge of your soil closed. Stuff as you go to ensure your pot is packed with fluff!

And you're DONE! Congratulations on making your Strawberry Pot. Display this piece on your desk or coffee table for an everlasting floral arrangement.
