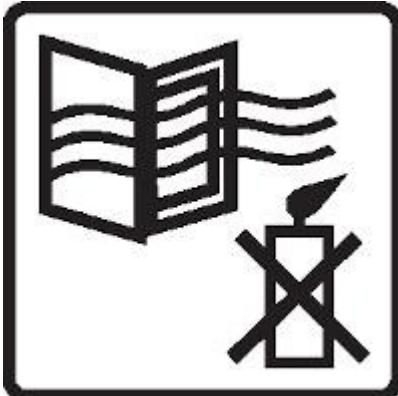

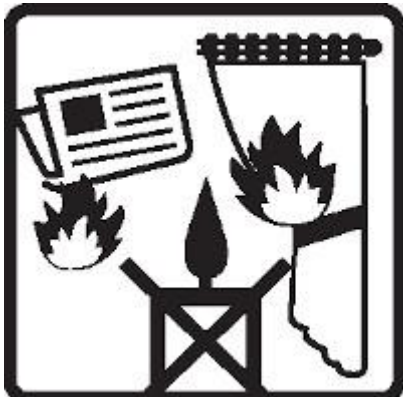
Do Not Burn in a Draught



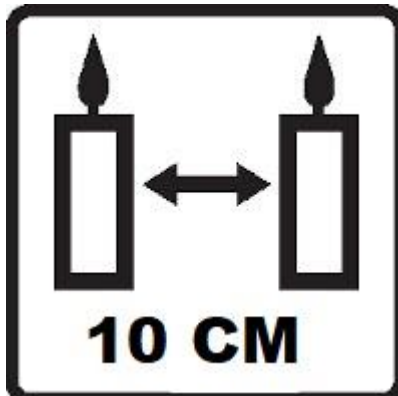
Do Not Touch, May Be Hot

Keep Away From Things That Can Catch Fire



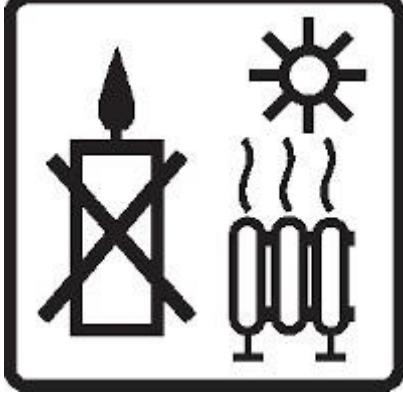
Keep Candles at Least 10 cm Apart











Do Not Burn in a Warming Unit







Do Not Move a Burning Candle



Do Not Place Near a Heat Source

	<p>Keep Away From Children and Pets</p>		<p>Never Leave a Burning Candle Unattended</p>
	<p>Never Use Liquid to Extinguish</p>		<p>Place Candle Upright</p>
	<p>Trim Edge if Higher Than 3cm</p>		<p>Trim Wick to 2cm</p>
	<p>Use a Heat Resistant Candle Holder</p>		<p>Snuff Out the Flame, Do Not Blow It Out</p>

	<p>Only Use in Holders and Warming Stoves with Sufficient Ventilation</p>		<p>Use in a Suitable Bowl Filled with Water for floating candles</p>
	<p>Remove Packaging Before Use</p>		<p>This Candle Liquifies, Use a Suitable Container</p>
