DSQUARED2 While many designers are focused on ying and yang city/country for autumn, DSquared2 focused on the younger, more irreverent dichotomy: rebels and prepsters. The general atmosphere was the 1960s preparatory school meets the detention hall. The bad guys wore sleek leather jackets, studded parks and (expensive) wax denim. There was a little more traction with a diligent set, looking smart in shirvelled one-breasted suits, colorful mohair crewnecks and our favorite: a preppy striped sweater with jeans and a short tweed coat. Lesson learned: When you really break it down, there's not much difference between classic and rebel. In many cases, it just depends on your outer layer. It's not hard to change your own look based on what you do or how you feel. Keep your shirt and pants simple, and add a statement coat-be it a leather jacket or tweed jacket to convey your attitude. STONE ISLAND It's the 30th anniversary of Stone Island, and the brand has recreated some of its greatest hits to celebrate the occasion. There's also plenty of new, innovative outerwear in hand-painted camouflage and thermal stitched down. Unsurprisingly, Stone Island has fans around the world who have been collecting these innovative pieces for three decades. Outstanding was the 30/30 Jacket, which has two layers, each reversible with the ability of any piece to wear on the outside. The end result is 30 different variations on how to put it together. The outer layer is a waterproof orange cotton that changes to a shiny olive with polyurethane coating. The silver inner layer has a thermal reflective fabric that darkens when it is cold, which turns into knit charcoal. Lesson learned: Read the label when you buy performance pieces, so you don't miss any of the unique attributes.
