

WINDOW/WALL DECALS

Decals are best suited for flat smooth surfaces such as walls and windows. These are not suited for floor use, as they are not slip resistant.

HOW TO APPLY

WHAT YOU WILL NEED: Surface cleaner (preferably alcohol based, not ammonia based) / Masking tape / Level (optional) / Pencil / Flat edge such as a squeegee or credit card (if using a credit card, wrap one long end in cloth so it does not scratch the decal during application)

STEP 1 • PREPARE THE SURFACE

Clean the surface where you plan to apply the decal thoroughly.

If available, using rubbing alcohol and a clean cloth. Avoid using an ammonia-based window cleaner, as ammonia can affect the adhesive on the decal and prevent it from sticking properly.

STEP 2 • POSITION THE DECAL

Using a level (if desired), tape your decal in place before removing the backing to ensure proper positioning. Mark the top two corners with a pencil or masking tape. This step will help you align the decal after the backing is removed, as it is difficult to reposition a decal once applied.

STEP 3 • INSTALL THE DECAL

Carefully remove the paper backing from the top corner of the decal and press the adhesive onto the application surface. Using a flat edge, start at the top and move downward, peeling the paper and pressing it onto the surface as you go.

Remove bubbles by working them toward the edges with a flat edge. For large decals, press down in the center of the decal and work outward with a flat edge to smooth down each side. For smaller designs, work from top to bottom or from one side to the other. Be careful not to press too hard or you run the risk of damaging your decal.

To remove a decal, gently lift the edge and slowly peel back. Use cleaning detergent to remove any adhesive residue left behind.

TIPS FOR INSTALLATION

Pay close attention to your surface where you plan to apply the decal. Decals will not stick well to a surface that's waxy or oily, and dirt caught under your decal can cause unattractive bumps or spots.

If you have a large decal, tape it to the application surface along the top with masking tape. This will hold the decal in place as you remove the backing underneath and provide more control as it adheres to the surface.
