

OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Hard Seltzer Company New Zealand Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **1043 Camerons Line, Feilding** and known as **Native Sparkling**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

Endorsement

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday – 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.
3. No direct “walk in/walkout” sales may be made from the premises.
4. The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the license holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires.
5. A copy of the licence or a clearly identified link to use an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
6. The following steps must be taken to verify that people are over the purchase age:
In the case of an order made using an internet site, telephone order or physical order – the prospective buyer must declare that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and where the prospective receiver is involved that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over)
 - (i) **Once, when the prospective buyer first commences the order process; and**
 - (ii) **Again, immediately before the sale of alcohol is completed.**

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) Either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
