

2014 Elephant Hill Rosé

Located in Hawke's Bay, our vineyards enjoy a temperate, dry climate and an extended growing season allowing us to grow wines that display wonderful fruit purity and elegance. Every wine crafted by Elephant Hill is made with fruit hand-picked from sustainably-run vineyards.

The 2014 Rosé is a blend of 78% Tempranillo from our Triangle Vineyard and 22% Syrah from our Te Awanga Vineyard. After hand-picking the grapes were whole bunch pressed and co-fermented in stainless steel tank at a cool 16c with a separate small proportion fermented in oak.

Rosé to us is all about freshness, flavour and colour and the 2014 is an excellent example of this. Crisp and dry with bright red current characters balanced with lovely fresh acidity. It is a perfect wine to enjoy as an aperitif and will match a wide variety of foods like antipasti, salads, seafood and paella.
