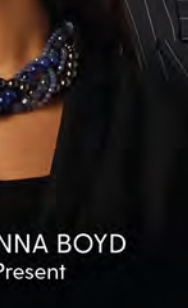
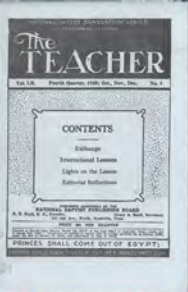

THE MISSION OF THE R.H. BOYD FAMILY ENDOWMENT FUND

The purpose of our scholarships and grants

Oversee special projects, such as the renovation of the Boyd House

We invite you to join in a historic opportunity to partner with us in the renovation of the Boyd House on the campus of Fisk University. The home was originally owned by Dr. Henry Allen Boyd, second-generation leader of the National Baptist Publishing Board (NBPB), now R.H. Boyd, and his wife Georgia Bradford Boyd, a suffragist and a prominent community voice for the advancement of women's and children's issues.

We recently launched a \$1.1 million nationwide campaign to restore this early-twentieth-century Edwardian-style home, which is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places. The home is being renovated to create academic spaces, such as classrooms and a lecture hall, and to build opportunities to further the educational pursuits of students in business and entrepreneurship.

SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT PROGRAMS

There are seven scholarship and grant classifications under the endowment program. These categories were selected to incorporate a broad spectrum, and support the business functions and mission of R.H. Boyd.

The Boyd Undergraduate Scholarship

Awarded to a rising junior or senior African-American students attending an accredited four-year institution majoring in finance, business administration, journalism, theology/religion, or any major approved by the R.H. Boyd Family Endowment Fund Committee.

The Boyd Undergraduate Scholarship for Fisk University

Awarded to a rising junior or senior at Fisk University majoring in finance, business administration, journalism, theology, history, English, or computer science.

The Boyd Fellow

Awarded to African-American students pursuing a master's or doctoral degree in the fields of finance, business administration, journalism, theology/religion, or any major as approved by the R.H. Boyd Family Endowment Fund Committee.

The Boyd Employee Scholarship

Through R.H. Boyd Publishing Corporation, the R.H. Boyd Family Endowment Fund has established the Employee Scholarship Program. This is awarded to R.H. Boyd employees pursuing degrees in the areas of finance, marketing, business administration, journalism, and theology/religion which would enhance the overall effectiveness of our various business divisions.

The Boyd Grant

Awarded to churches, organizations, and businesses seeking to improve their communities through projects and programs that have a positive impact on society, faith community, families, or individuals.

The Dr. LaDonna Y. Boyd Annual Scholarship

Awarded to junior or senior African-American women attending Spelman College in pursuit of a Bachelor of Arts degree in economics with a 3.25 GPA or higher. Students may apply for this scholarship directly through Spelman College.

The R.H. Boyd Family Endowment Fund Scholarship at Tennessee State University

Three scholarships awarded yearly to full time, in-state students at Tennessee State University in pursuit of a four-year degree in business or other field of study, with a GPA greater than 3.0. Students may apply for this scholarship directly through Tennessee State University.

PURPOSE Preparatory Academy

PURPOSE PREPARATORY ACADEMY

Purpose Preparatory Academy, a Nashville charter school, is one of the district's leading schools serving African-American and economically disadvantaged students. Purpose Prep is a three-time Reward School and the first elementary school in North Nashville to achieve this status for academic performance—ranking within the top 5 percent of schools in the state. Purpose Prep has become a “Level 5” school, the highest designation by the district, for growth and achievement in English Language Arts and in math—among other achievements.

R. H. Boyd Service Award



REPRESENTATIVE JUSTIN JONES

MEMBER OF THE TENNESSEE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, DISTRICT 52

Justin Jones is an activist, graduate student, and community organizer in Nashville. He graduated from Fisk University with a B.A. in political science and is completing a Master of Theological Studies degree at Vanderbilt University.

Justin has been arrested more than a dozen times for nonviolent protests and has been recognized for his activism with awards from the Tennessee Human Rights Commission, ACLU of Tennessee, Tennessee Alliance for Progress, Fisk University Alumni Association, the Vanderbilt Organization of Black Graduate Students, and the Nashville NAACP.

Justin currently serves as the youngest Black lawmaker in Tennessee and represents House District 52 in Nashville. On April 6, he was one of two legislators expelled for standing with students and constituents protesting for common sense gun laws.

As Justin stated: "We were calling for you to ban assault weapons, you responded by assaulting democracy." He was reinstated to his post by the Nashville city council as an interim representative three days later and will run to serve as the district's permanent representative during a special election in August.

R. H. Boyd Excellence Award



TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY ARISTOCRAT OF BANDS

Founded in 1946, the Aristocrat of Bands (AOB) is a high-stepping, show-style marching band from the historically Black Tennessee State University in Nashville.

They were the first HBCU to appear on national television, performing during the 1955 Rams vs. Bears NFL game halftime show, the first HBCU to perform at a Presidential Inauguration, performing for John F. Kennedy in 1961, the first band to play on the White House lawn, showcasing as the guest of President Barack Obama to kick off the National Museum of African American History and Culture grand opening celebration in 2016. Most recently, the AOB became the first marching band to ever win a Grammy Award.

The school was founded in 1999, and in the fall of 2000, 14 students walked in the door and began ballet training. During the past 21 years more than 2,000 students from diverse backgrounds have received excellent dance education from a professional faculty in an environment focused on diversity and Christian formation. The whole dancer is respected and loved.

All dancers at Rejoice pay on an income-based sliding scale. Approximately 80 percent of our students pay \$17 a month for classes, dance wear, and costumes.

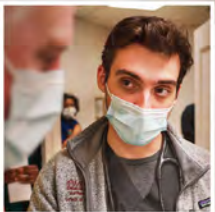

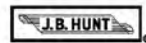

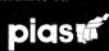
