Safety Tips

- Position on a flat, stable surface.
- A service agent/qualified technician should carry out installation and any repairs if required.

- DO NOT immerse the appliance in water, or use jet/pressure washers to clean the appliance.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant inside the appliance.
- Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Always switch off and disconnect the power supply to the appliance when not in use.
- Not suitable for outdoor use.
- Keep all packaging away from children. Dispose of the packaging in accordance to the regulations of local authorities.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a Polar agent or a recommended qualified technician in order to avoid a hazard.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

Installation



Note: If the appliance has been stored or moved in a non-vertical position, stand it in an upright position for approximately 12 hours before operation. If in doubt allow to stand.

- Remove the appliance from the packaging and remove the protective film from all surfaces.
- When positioning, maintain a distance of 20cm (7 inches) between the appliance and walls or other objects for ventilation. NEVER LOCATE NEXT TO OR NEAR A HEAT SOURCE.

Note: Before using the appliance for the first time, clean the shelves and interior with soapy water.

Turn On

- 1. Close the doors of the appliance.
- 2. Connect the appliance to the mains power supply.
- 3. To switch refrigeration system on or off press and hold () for 3 seconds.
- 4. Press the light button "of" to turn the light On or Off as required.

Adjusting the Temperature

- 1. Press button for 1 second. The set temperature on the LCD display will flash.
- 2. Press up button or down button to change the set temperature.
- Wait 6 seconds for the set temperature to be stored.

Manual Defrost

- To start manual defrosting press and hold the defrost button tf for 3 seconds.
- Press and hold to stop.
- **Note:** You can shortly press to check the evaporator temperature.

Manual Demist

- To start demisting press and hold the demist button for 3 seconds.
- 2. Press and hold \$\$\$ for 3 seconds again to stop.

Cleaning, Care & Maintenance



Switch off and disconnect from the power supply before cleaning.

- The doors can be removed for ease of cleaning.
- Clean the interior of the appliance as often as possible.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents. These can leave harmful residues.
- Clean the door seals with warm soapy water.
- Always wipe dry after cleaning.

Replacing the Interior Lamp

Call your POLAR dealer or a qualified electrician, the Lamp Assembly is available to purchase as a spare part.

Cleaning the condenser



- Switch off and disconnect from the power supply before cleaning.
- The condenser is part of the refrigeration system. The condenser requires monthly cleaning.
- 1. The condenser is located on the right-hand side of the refrigeration cabinet at the rear.
- 2. Remove the screws fixing the ventilation panel.
- 3. Remove the panel to access the filter. Clean with a vacuum cleaner.
- 4. Re-locate the filter.
- 5. Re-attach the panel and fix it with the screws removed beforehand.

Troubleshooting

If the machine malfunctions due to causes other than those listed or the proposed corrective actions do not solve the problem please call a Polar agent or qualified technician.

Electrical Wiring

The plug is to be connected to a suitable mains socket.

POLAR appliances are wired as follows:

- Live wire (coloured brown) to terminal marked L
- Neutral wire (coloured blue) to terminal marked N
- Earth wire (coloured green/yellow) to terminal marked E

This appliance must be earthed.



If in doubt consult a qualified electrician.

Electrical isolation points must be kept clear of any obstructions. In the event of any emergency disconnection being required they must be readily accessible.
