

INSTALLATION STEPS


1. Acclimate

Once you receive your wood planks, open the boxes and remove the planks. Make sure you keep the inner straps around the bundle of planks. Set them in the install area to acclimate for 48 to 72+ hours.




2. Wall Prep

Before installing your wall, remove and outline your electrical covers with a pencil to ensure you hide all of your edges behind the cover for an aesthetically pleasing finish.




3. Plan Layout

Layout your wood planks on the ground and separate the pieces by size, that way when installing you can eliminate waste by picking the perfect size and achieve a beautiful staggered pattern.




4. First Row

Choose your starting point. You can start at the top corner and work down, or you can start along the baseboard and work your way up. The most important thing is that you use a level to draw a starting line for the first row to ensure it is straight.




5. Glue (Recommended)

To ensure a strong hold, we recommend using a polyurethane construction adhesive (brands like PL Glue or Liquid Nails). Apply glue in an S-shape on the back of the plank and place onto your wall.




6. Nail

Nail evenly across each plank with a nail gun to ensure a flush finish. Thin finish nails (hidden head nails) are recommended to fasten the planks to your wall. 18 gauge brad nails 1 1/2" work great. Keep nails at least 3/4" distance from the edges of planks.




7. Finish Row

Cut end pieces to fit and complete each row. We recommend using your end cuts to start new rows to achieve a beautiful pattern and to minimize waste.




8. Repeat

Use a shorter length (cut one if necessary) to stagger and begin the next row. Repeat this process until your wall is complete and enjoy!




9. Last Row

The last row may be smaller than the width of the planks, so you may need to trim it along the length of the board to fit the last row.




10. Outlets, Windows And Cutouts

Use a jigsaw to cut the planks to fit around any electrical outlets, windows, door casings, and other cutouts.
