## Understanding Kromkamp

The CNC sign on the top of the tube indicates the category:

**C**

Children, for the specific needs of young skaters.

**L**

Lightweight, offering flexibility and ease.

**A**

Medium, for standard stiffness.

**AS**

Medium Rigid, a balance between flexibility and firmness.

**S**

Rigid, for maximum support and performance.

## Blade types

For the radius at the bottom of the tube:

**R11**

Rigid/firm, for maximum stability.

**R3**

Lightweight/flexible, for greater maneuverability.

**R8**

Children's model, designed for young skaters.

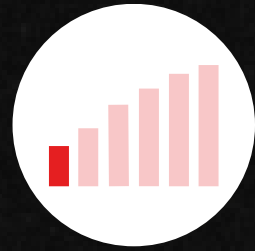
