What does intelligent design mean? **Since God is all-powerful, all-knowing, and knows what the plans are for everything He creates, He would have created everything and every organism to perfectly fit into His creation. Included in this concept is that organisms would have been endowed with the exactly correct DNA to fulfill His plan.**
32. What objections do evolutionists have with the creation model? **Evolutionists feel it isn't scientific to believe in something that cannot be proven, and they do not believe the existence of God can be proven. Therefore, to believe in creation is not scientific.**
33. True or False? The belief that information adding mutations are an explanation for the diversity of life is based on scientific fact. **False. There has never been one information-adding mutation proven to occur, nor has there ever been one induced in a scientific setting. Evolutionist's have a faith-based belief that information-adding mutations occur since they have never been proven to occur.**
34. True or False? Creationists do not believe that natural selection occurs. **False. They do believe it occurs.**
35. Is the example of a dark-living species of animal losing their eyes over time evolution? Why or why not? **An organism losing a trait is not evidence of evolution. Evolution requires a gain of information that causes new, never-before-in-existence traits to form so that one kind of organism transforms into an entirely new and never-before-in-existence kind (the evolutionary example would be a fish gaining information and traits so that it transforms into an amphibian). When mutation causes loss of sight, it's caused by a loss of genetic information, not a gain as evolution requires. Additionally, the organisms that have lost their eyes are still the same kind of organism after they lost their eyes as they were before (eyeless, blind fish are still the fish kind); hence, no new, never-before-in-existence organism has arisen. This kind of genetic change would never lead to evolution.**
36. True or False? If information-adding mutations did occur, they would likely make an organism less likely to survive in their environment and cause them to be selected out of the population through natural selection. **True.**
37. True or False? A transitional form is an animal that shows traits of the organism it is evolving from and changing into. **True.**
38. True or False? The evolution model proposes that fossil-containing rock layers (strata) form rapidly while non-fossil containing layers form slowly even though they look like they formed by the same processes. **True.**
39. True or False? The reason that evolution is so appealing as an explanation for the origin of life and species is because it is supported by hard scientific facts. **False. Evolution lacks scientific merit and frequently is contradicted by science. It requires a lot of faith to believe in the evolution model.**
