- p. 10, paragraph immediately after Figure 1.2.3, line 7 should read: However, if the hypothesis does not accurately predict the experimental data collected, one of two things needs to occur: either the hypothesis needs to be reformulated or it needs to be discarded.
- p. 45, second paragraph, line 3 should read: Multicellular organisms are even more complex and organized because they contain **tissues**. Tissues are groups of cells with different functions that join together for a common purpose.
- p. 53, the definition of tissue should read: A collection of different types of cells that group together to perform a common function.
