

## USING MUSEUMS IN HOMESCHOOL





- -Object-based Learning: Museums, aquariums, and zoos help you and your children partake in kinethstetic learning.
- -The Museum Experience: Museums, aquariums, and zoos (whether biblical or secular) allow you to experience God's creation first-hand.
- -Curriculum Integration: Help your children grasp curriculum concepts with hands-on learning (e.g.: When your student is studying botany, visit a local greenhouse or botanical garden).



- 1. **Teach your children** that the Lord is the sovereign Creator and Sustainer over all of life as we read in Scripture and see in our daily lives. **Consider** Jeremiah 32:17: What does this passage teach us about God? What does this passage teach us about what we see in a museum exhibit or at a zoo that reminds us of God's loving-kindness?
- 2. **Show your children** God's goodness as His creation testifies to the Truth found in Scripture.

**Consider** Matthew 6:26: How does this show God's goodness? What do we see in every day life that reminds us of God's loving-kindness?

3. **Point your children** to Jesus Christ as revealed in Scripture and use examples in His life to show the ultimate work He did for us.


**Consider** Psalm 18:2: What does this show us about who God is? What do we see at the aquarium that reminds us of this attribute of God?
