Window Wall Gasket is secured to the edge of slab or directly to the window wall unit sill to drape into the gap between the firerated floor and the slab cover. When exposed to temperatures in excess of 350°F (177°C) during a fire, the gasket begins to expand (intumesce) rapidly to form a dense, highly insulative char.

Applications

In window wall construction, the void between the concrete slab and the slab cover provides a direct path for heat and flames to compromise the vision panel sill on the top surface of the floor. Window Wall Gasket activates when heated to seal off the void area and block the spread of flames and hot gases. Window Wall Gasket meets the exacting criteria of ASTM E2307 for up to a 2 hour fire rating and is Intertek listed.






