Who May Enter: This exhibition is an open exhibition. All ages may enter, mothers, fathers, daughters, sons, grandchildren. There is no particular theme for art or poetry.

There are four (4) parts to this form. All four (4) parts must be submitted by their deadline dates in order to be included in the exhibition.

Calendar (Printable forms below)

Part I: Entry Deadline: Feb 14. Artists and poets submit their intent to exhibit their art and poem to exhibition chairs. NOTE: artwork and poems do not need to be done at this time. This entry deadline is to pair up artists and poets with each other if they do not know who they are going to work with.

Artists and poets are expected to find a partner to work with on their own. Christine and Nancy will compile the names of the artists and the names of the poets who are looking for a partner and send it out to those individuals who haven't found a partner. Artists and poets can then work off that list which will include information about artists/poets style (see Form I, Intent to Exhibit below).

There are three ways to enter:

 Need to pair with artist or poet: Christine will compile names of artists and poets and their respective styles and send it out to unpaired individuals. Artists and poets are then free to pair with others on the list. Send filled out form labeled Part I, via email or snail mail to either Nancy Austin or Christine Alfery by the deadline Feb. 14. - 2. Artists/Poets may pair with themselves (i.e. do both the poetry and the artwork).
- 3. Artists may find their own poet; poets may find their own artist, they do not need to pair with someone on the list.

Part II: Deadline: March 14. Artists and Poets submit their names as a team. Note poets and artists may pair up with themselves. Examples: Poet: Christine Alfery Artist: Christine Alfery or Poet: Nancy Austin - Artist Christine Alfery. Submit to contacts Christine or Nancy via email or snail mail. Contact information listed under three ways to enter.

Part III: Entry Deadline: May 2. Titles, media and price submitted by artist. Poem in correct format (a readable font type and font size, one page for display) submitted. Submit to contact Christine or Nancy via email or snail mail. Contact information listed under three ways to enter.

Part IV: Hold Harmless Form Due at check in June 3-4 10:00 AM-1:00PM

Book — we are going to publish a chap book for this exhibition. Poets and Artists will be able to purchase one of these books. Until we know how many artists/poets will be part of this exhibition we cannot give you a price for it yet. Please note will be selling these books at our cost. For examples of books that have been created in the past for the Artist Muse Exhibition see the attachments to this email.

Check In and Set Up: June 3-4 10:00 AM—1:00 PM Artist and poet bring artwork and poem to hang in the gallery. Artist and poet will hang their own work, instructions will be given. Poets will laminate poems at this time.

Take Down: August 12, 10:00 AM-1:00 PM

Guidelines for set up.

- All artwork must be framed and ready to hang. Ready to hang means that the frame is wired on the back, no sawtooth hanger. Labels should follow the format below and taped to the back of the artwork.
- All poetry must be laminated and one page only. Poets will be able to laminate their poems on setup day it they were unable to have it done prior. Just give

yourself enough time to laminate your poem on museum equipment if you choose to laminate the poem on the check in date.

- Entries must be original works of art, entirely the work of the entrant.
- Artwork must not have been shown before, at the Howard Young Art Gallery unless arranged ahead of time with Gallery Curator, Christine Alfery.
- There is no entry fee.
