Rainbow Stroller Blanket - WildWestDye - by Rebecca Glazier

This blanket is suitable for all knitters, from beginners to experienced.

All you need to know, is how to cast on, knit, purl and cast off.

Designed to be made with WildWestDye's Naturally dyed soft DK weight yarn.



Yarn:

WildWestDye Naturally soft DK weight yarn. $6 \times 50 \text{g}/6 \times 1.7 \text{oz}$ 300g / 10.6 oz total

Needles:

 $5 \text{mm}/\,\text{US}$ size 8 needles for cast on. $4 \text{mm}/\,\text{US}$ size 6 needles for pattern.

Notions:

Darning needle for sewing in the ends

Gauge:

17 stitches to 10cm on 4mm/ US size 6 needles once blocked.

Size:

Width: 61cm / 24" Length: 76cm / 30" Blocked measurements. Rainbow Stroller Blanket: Using 5mm needles cast on 105 stitches.

Change to 4mm needles.

All rows: (K1, p1) repeat to end.

Knit each colour in the rainbow: Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple. Or in any order you like!

Cast off losely, use 5mm needles if needed and block.
