













QUICK START



Plug the power cord into an outlet.



Press the **Power Button** to turn on the projector.




Adjust the kickstand accordingly.



Move the focus to the right to take off the lens cover.



Select the correct input source by pressing the (a) button.



Connect your device to the projector correctly.



Adjust the keystone and the focus to get the best image performance.




Press the **Power Button** twice to turn off the projector.

Press ⓐ on the projector or remote to enter the interface of Input Source.


A. USB 1 Connection



B. USB 2 Connection




C. HD Connection






PROJECTOR CONNECTION

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

- 1. What should I do if I get blurry images?
- * Adjust focus ring/keystone.
- * Projector and screen/wall must be in effective distance.
- 2. What should I do if the remote is unresponsive?
- * Make sure remote points at IR receiver directly.
- * Do not cover IR receiver.
- * Try a new pair of AAA batteries.
- 3. How do I flip the upside-down images?
- * Go to Menu > PICTURE > Projection Direction to flip the projection image.
- 4. How do I restore the projector to factory default?
- * Go to Menu > OPTION > Restore Factory Default to restore factory settings as needed.
- 5. How do I set the language?
- * Go to Menu > OPTION > OSD Language to select the language.


