## RING SIZE GUIDE

If you don't know your ring size you have a few options:

1. Go to a jeweller and ask them to measure you
2. If you have another ring of the same size measure it by placing it on one of the circles below or measuring the inside diameter of the ring with a ruler.

If you know your ring size in Australian, UK, or North America sizes, simply go to table below, find your ring size and follow the US size.
