John Frazer creates this Shiraz using grapes solely from his small vineyard plot on the family estate located in the renowned Wilyabrup sub-region of Margaret River. This particular wine is the sole still wine crafted by Frazer Woods.

TASTING NOTES

Made entirely from estate-grown fruit, this Shiraz is the only still wine that John Frazer makes – and it's an absolute cracker! Beautiful, bright red berry aromas on the nose, with subtle hints of spice, the palate is deliciously smooth and silky, cherry and cranberry red fruit notes, well-integrated and velvety tannins, all brought together with some juicy acidity in a lovely long finish.

WINEMAKING

Sourced exclusively from a small block of vines on the family estate. Hand-picked and carefully processed to retain fresh fruit flavours and natural acidity. Fruit was hand-picked, de-stemmed and matured in a 2700L French oak 'Egg' for 12 months.

VINTAGE NOTES

We experienced an early beginning to the season, as warmer-than-average spring temperatures transitioned into ideal summer growing conditions. The timely flowering of native Marri trees resulted in low disease pressure. The favourable weather and reduced yields allowed ample time for the fruit to mature to perfection.
