

METHOD 01 - I DON'T KNOW MY SIZE

- A. Print the PDF in A4 making sure the printer is set at 100%
- B. Cut out the template below and create a slit where indicated ("SLIT HERE").
- C. Roll up the ring sizer around your finger and slide it through the slit.
- D. For an accurate measurement, pull the sizer tight over the widest part of your finger (e.g. the knuckle).
- E. Draw a mark that lines up next to the slit.
- F. Measure with a ruler the length from the slit to your mark. This is the **CIRCUMFERENCE** of your finger.
- G. Look for the corresponding tabulated size. (Remember the circumference measures in the table are in millimeters).

Cut the ring sizer below:

Tips for accurate measurements:

- Don't measure your finger when it's too cold or too hot.
- The size of the same finger of left and right hand can be different.

METHOD 02 – MEASURE ONE OF YOUR RING

- A. Choose a ring that fits your finger.
- B. Place the ring over the circles below. Match the inside edge of the ring with the closest circle. This is the inside **DIAMETER** of the ring.
- C. If the ring falls between two sizes, select the larger of the two.
- D. Look for the corresponding tabulated size.
