What's in the Box













Whats in the Box:

- Primuim cell phone case
- Screen protector
- Display cleaning wipe
- Microfiber towelette
- Large dust removal sticker

Installation Guide

1. Prepare Your Phone and Case

- Start by cleaning your phone to remove any dust, dirt, or fingerprints. Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen and the back.
- Clean the inside of the phone case as well, ensuring it's free of debris that could scratch your phone.

2. Inspect the Case

 Before installation, inspect the case for any defects such as sharp edges or cracks that could damage your phone or make the case less effective.

3. Align Your Phone

- Hold your phone with the screen facing you.
- Align the phone bottom with the case bottom. (Refer to image A)

4. Insert Your Phone

- Gently press the phone into the case, Make sure the buttons line up with the button cutouts on the case. (Refer to image A)
- Ease each corner of your phone into the case. You may need to slightly stretch the corners of the case to accommodate the phone.

5. Secure the Phone in Place


 Once the phone is placed inside the case, press down on all corners and sides to ensure it's fully seated. You should hear a soft click or feel the phone snugly fit into place, indicating the case is secure. (Refer to image B)

6. Final Checks

- After the phone is in the case, go around the edges and press down to ensure there are no loose areas or gaps.
- Check the alignment of the camera and any ports to make sure the case doesn't obstruct them.
- Test the buttons to ensure they have a good tactile response through the case. If they feel stiff or unresponsive, adjust the alignment of the phone within the case or check for any obstructions.

7. Adjust as Needed

- If the case has screen protectors or covers, adjust them to avoid air bubbles or misalignment.
- If any parts of the phone are not fitting well, gently remove the phone and repeat the installation process, paying special attention to alignment.




Buttons/Logo Installation Guide




Button Installation

- Identify the Correct Button Placement: Match the volume and power buttons on your phone with the corresponding placeholders on the case.
- 2. Align the Buttons: Position the buttons over their respective slots, ensuring they are the right way up.
- 3. Press the Buttons into Place: Gently press each button into its slot until it clicks into place and is flush with the surface of the case.



Test Fitment

Test Button Functionality: Press each button to ensure it has a clear, tactile response. If a button feels 'mushy,' adjust its position until you feel a distinct click with each press.



Logo Installation


- 1. **Prepare the Logo:** Take the logo piece and ensure it is clean and free of debris.
- 2. Locate the Logo Slot: Find the opening at the bottom of the case designed for the logo.
- 3. Insert the Logo: Position the logo correctly over the opening and press firmly from the inside of the case to secure it in place.
- 4. Ensure a Flush Fit: Check from the outside that the logo sits flush with the case's surface and there are no gaps.

Routine Inspection and Maintenance:


 Our phone cases with preinstalled components are designed to withstand normal daily use without issue. However, we advise customers to periodically check these components to ensure they remain secure. By following these steps, your Phone Rebel camera lens will be securely installed and ready for use. For any issues during installation or if you require assistance, please contact our support team at Support@phonerebel.com.

Installing your Phone Rebel camera lens is a straightforward process. Follow these steps to ensure a secure and proper fit:

1. Prepare the Camera Lens and Case

- Ensure the camera lens is clean and free of fingerprints or dust.
- Locate the camera cut-out on your Phone Rebel case, where you will find notches that match the slots on your camera lens.

2. Align the Camera Lens (Refer to image F)

- Carefully align the lens with the case's camera cut-out. The lens should only fit one way, the notches on the case should line up precisely with the slots on the lens.
- Once aligned, gently place the lens into the cut-out.

3. Secure the Lens with Screws (Refer to image G)

- Your camera lens comes with four small screws that fit into the corners of the lens.
- Start by placing each screw into its respective hole
- Using the provided screwdriver, tighten each screw gradually. Do not fully tighten one screw before starting the next—instead, rotate between the screws, giving each a few turns to ensure even pressure and alignment.
- Once all screws are in place, finish tightening each until snug. Avoid over-tightening to prevent damage to the lens or case.

4. Dispose of the Screwdriver Safely

 After installation, it is recommended to dispose of the small screwdriver to prevent any safety risks or choking hazards. Ensure it is out of reach of children and properly discarded according to local regulations.

5. Final Inspection

- After all screws have been securely tightened, inspect the lens to ensure it is flush with the case and there are no gaps.
- Check that the lens cover does not obstruct the camera's view and that all camera functions operate correctly.


Screen Protector Installation Guide

NOTE: use the install kit included in the screen protector pouch.




Clean the Phone Screen

Use the provided cleaning wipe to thoroughly clean the surface of your phone's screen, ensuring all fingerprints and smudges are removed.




Dry the Screen

With the microfiber cloth, dry the screen to ensure there is no residue or moisture left.



Remove Dust Particles

Gently press the dust sticker onto the screen to lift away any remaining dust particles, which prevents air bubbles under the screen protector.



Peel Off the Screen Protector Plastic Film

Carefully peel the protective film off the screen protector, being careful not to touch the adhesive side.



Align and Place the Screen Protector

Align the screen protector with your phone's screen, using the notches or cutouts as a guide. Place the screen protector gently onto the screen. If it's not perfectly aligned, you can slightly lift the edge using your nail



Adhere and Smooth Out

Starting from the center, run the microfiber cloth down the screen to adhere the protector to the phone screen. If any bubbles appear, gently push them towards the edges with the cloth. Finally, press firmly around the edges of the screen protector to secure its bond to the screen.

Child Safety Warning:

 While Phone Rebel products are not designed for children's use, our phone cases come with preinstalled small components that could pose a choking hazard. It is the purchaser's responsibility to ensure that these components do not present a risk, particularly around children.

For Customers Purchasing Removable Components Separately.

- If you're buying accessory components, we recommend keeping them out of children's reach and ensuring they are properly installed and secured:
- Buttons: Test for proper installation by checking for a tactile click. If the buttons feel "mushy," reseat them to ensure they're correctly positioned.
- Logos: Install from the inside of the case, pushing firmly to guarantee a flush fit against the case's back.
- Lens Rings: Accompanied by small screws and a screwdriver for installation. Regularly check and tighten these screws as necessary. After installation, dispose of the small screwdriver to prevent any safety risks.

Installation Tips:

Make sure all components are correctly oriented and seated. For buttons, a proper installation
will result in a clear, tactile response. Logos should fit seamlessly into the case, and lens rings
should be securely fastened with their screws.
