How to Select an Exfoliant?

SKIN TYPE	PRIMARY SKIN CONCERN	EXFOLIANT RECOMMENDATION
AGING	Sun spots, thinning texture, laxity, fine lines & wrinkles, dryness	Chemical - particularly formulated with a bombo of AHAs. Pro tip - add dermaplaning before application of the exfoliant.
DEHYDRATED	Fine lines/cracks, flaking, rough texture, dryness	Chemical - particularly formulated with glycolic acid. Pro tip - add dermaplaning before application of the exfoliant.
PIGMENTED	Uneven skin tone, dark areas, sun spots	Chemical - particularly formulated with mandelic acid & other ingreds focused on combating melanogenesis.
SENSITIVE	Redness, rashes, uneven texture, itchy patches	Chemical - formulated with enzymes for gentle yet effective results. Dermaplaning is instantly effective and reduces the chance of reaction to a chemical exfoliant.
BLEMISH PRONE	Sallow appearance, excessive sebum, uneven texture, hyper keratinization	Chemical - formulated with BHA for acne fighting & oil regulation properties.
