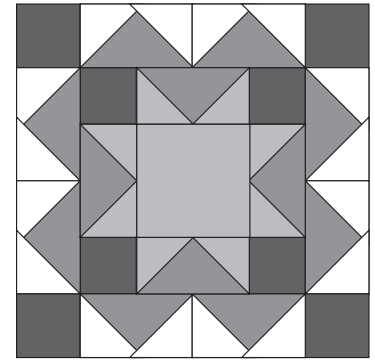

## Free Quilt Block Pattern

### Block 11: Eddystone Light



Use one light, two medium, and one dark fabric

#### Instructions:

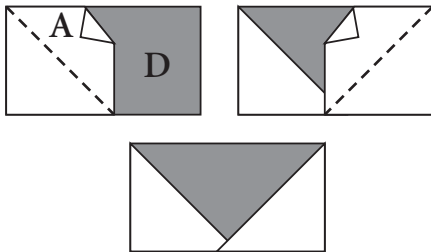
Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise stated.

#### 1. Cut fabrics:

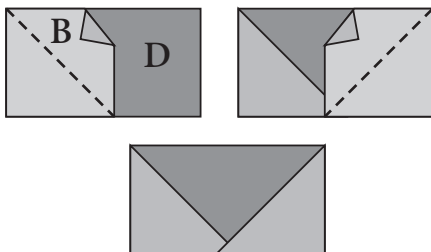
- Sixteen squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (light) - A
- Eight squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (medium 1) - B
- One square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" (medium 1) - C
- Twelve rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (medium 2) - D
- Eight squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (dark) - E

#### 2. Create flying geese blocks:

- Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of two light A squares. Layer one A square on one end of one medium 2 D rectangle, right sides together; pin in place. Stitch following the diagonal line across A square. Trim corner to a 1/4" seam allowance and press toward D. Repeat for opposite end of D, as shown below. Make eight light flying geese blocks.



- #### 3. Repeat step 2 using two medium 1 B squares and one medium 2 D rectangle. Make four medium flying geese blocks.



#### 4. Create block:

- Layout light and medium flying geese, C and E squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Eddystone Light block measuring 12 1/2" square.
