
Nancy's Notions' Free Quilt Block Pattern

Block 13: Courthouse Steps



Use three light, one medium, and two dark fabrics.

Instructions:


Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut fabrics:

- Two squares 2½" x 2½" (light) A
- Two squares 2½" x 2½" (dark 1) B
- Two rectangles 2½" x 4½" (light 2) C
- Two rectangles 2½" x 8½" (medium) D
- Two rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (light 3) E
- Two rectangles 21/2" x 121/2" (dark) F


2. Create 4-patch block:

• Sew two light A squares and two dark 1 B squares together into a unit, as shown; press toward dark. Sew the units together to create a 4-patch and press seam either open or one direction. Make one 4-patch block.



3. Create center section:

• Layout 4-patch block, C, and D rectangles, as shown. Sew pieces starting with 4-patch and C rectangles, press to sides. Continuing with D rectangles. Make one center section.



4. Create block:

Layout center section, E, and F rectangles, as shown.
 Sew outer rectangles to center section (press seams to side) to create the Courthouse Steps block measuring 12½" square.
