
Nancy's Notions' Free Quilt Block Pattern Block 17: Rising Star

Use one light and one dark fabric.


Instructions:

Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise stated.

- 1. Cut fabrics:
 - Eight squares 31/2" x 31/2" (dark)—A
 - Four rectangles 3¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" (light)—B
 - Eight squares 2" x 2" (dark)—C
 - Four rectangles 2" x 3½" (light)—D
 - Four squares 3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂" (light)—E
 - Four squares 2" x 2" (light)—F
 - One square 31/2" x 31/2" (dark)—G
- 2. Create flying geese blocks:
 - Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of eight light A squares. Place one A square on one end of B rectangle, right sides together; pin in place. Stitch, following the diagonal line across A square. Trim corner to a ¼" seam allowance and press toward A. Repeat for opposite end of B, as shown below. Make four large flying geese blocks.



3. Repeat step 2 using eight C squares and four D rectangles. Make four small flying geese blocks.



- 4. Assemble quilt block:
 - Layout squares and flying geese blocks, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite directions. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Weathervane block, measuring 12¹/₂" square.
