# Nancy's Notions Free Quilt Block Pattern 

## Block 17: Rising Star

Use one light and one dark fabric.


## Instructions:

Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut fabrics:

- Eight squares $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (dark)—A
- Four rectangles $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (light)—B
- Eight squares 2" x 2" (dark)—C
- Four rectangles 2" x $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (light)—D
- Four squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (light)—E
- Four squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ (light)—F
- One square $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (dark)—G

2. Create flying geese blocks:

- Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of eight light A squares. Place one A square on one end of B rectangle, right sides together; pin in place. Stitch, following the diagonal line across A square. Trim corner to a ${ }^{1 / 4}$ " seam allowance and press toward A. Repeat for opposite end of B, as shown below. Make four large flying geese blocks.


3. Repeat step 2 using eight $C$ squares and four $D$ rectangles. Make four small flying geese blocks.

4. Assemble quilt block:

- Layout squares and flying geese blocks, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite directions. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Weathervane block, measuring $12^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
