## Nancy's Notions' Free Quilt Block Pattern Block 1: Jacob's Ladder

Use one light and one dark fabric.

## Instructions:


Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut fabrics:


- Ten squares 21/2" x 21/2" (light) A
- Ten squares 21/2" x 21/2" (dark) B
- Two squares 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" (light) C
- Two squares 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" (dark) D


## 2. Create 4-patch block:

• Sew two light A squares and two dark B squares together into a unit, as shown; press toward dark. Sew the units together to create a 4-patch and press seam either open or one direction. Make five blocks.



- 3. Create half square triangle blocks:
  - Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of one light C square and place it on one dark D square; pin in place. Stitch a ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut in half and press half square triangle toward D. Make four blocks.





- 4. Create block:
  - Layout 4-patch and half square triangles, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Jacob's Ladder block measuring 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square.
