## Free Quilt Block Pattern


### Block 5: Wyoming

Use one light, one medium, and two dark fabrics.


#### **Instructions:**


Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise stated.

- 1. Cut fabrics:
  - Four squares 2½" x 2½" (light) A
  - Eight squares 27/8" x 27/8" (light) B
  - Four rectangles 2½" x 4½" (medium) C
  - Four squares 2%" x 2%" (medium) D
  - Four squares 2%" x 2%" (dark 1) E
  - One square 4½" x 4½" (dark 2) F
  - Four squares 2½" x 2½" (dark 2) G
- 2. Create half square triangle blocks:
  - Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of one light B square and place it on one medium Dsquare; pin in place. Stitch a ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut in half and press toward D. Make eight medium half square triangle blocks.




3. Repeat Step 2 using four light B squares and four dark 1 E squares. Make eight dark half square triangle blocks.







 Sew together one dark half square triangle and one light A square. Press toward A. Sew together one dark half square triangle and one dark G square. Press toward G. Sew the two pairs together and press seam in one direction or open. Make four 4-patch blocks.



#### 5. Create crown blocks:

 Sew together two medium half square triangle squares. Press seam to one side or open. Sew lower edge of half square triangle pair to one medium rectangle C. Press seam toward C. Make four crown blocks.





### 6. Create block:

 Layout 4-patch, crown, and F square, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Wyoming block measuring 12½" square.
